They were both NO votes by the way. An 80% turnout of the Meadow's members is magnificent. A plurality of 68% to 32% is more than two to one. I'd like to thank the Election Committee for the professional job they did with such a large turnout. "Kudos" to Chair Lillian Krall, Joan Pagans, Janet Armus, Ann Davies, Mary Ann Reed, Birgit Viehe, Hugh & Grace Burritt, Pat Sous and Jack Daly.

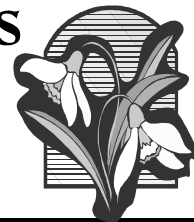

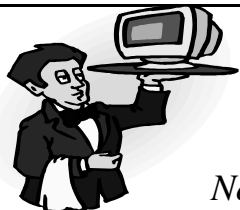
RULES ROUND-UP *Love 'em or hate 'em, the rules are the rules*

The goal of this monthly article is to remind us of the current by-laws and rules. Hopefully, it will promote compliance, discussion and revision if needed. This is OUR community. We all share the common goal of living in a beautiful neighborhood and increasing our property values. This is an excerpt of the subject matter of our by-laws.

X. Rules & Regulations

3. Residence Use B. ... Owners may have their guests use their homes provided they advise the Board of Directors in Writing at least 2 weeks prior to use. They must include guest names , relationship to the owner (family of friend), and ages, duration of stay limited to 30 days.) .. a statement that the guests have been informed and will abide by the Rules, Regulations and By-Laws of the Meadows of Crystal Lake

As the summer season is around the corner, it is important to understand that child visitors (under the age of 18 years old) are limited to 30 days per year. All residents must inform their visitors that they must abide by the same rules as residents for all common areas and when using the amenities, such as the pool, shuffle board and tennis courts. So if the kids, nieces, nephews, grand children, or great grand-children will be visiting remember to limit their stay to 30 days.
