## Where is St. Andrew located?

We are located at 1605 Neuse Boulevard in the historic district of New Bern, NC.

## Where do I park?

St. Andrew is surrounded by easily accessible parking spaces. Entry to the parking lot can be made from Catawba Street. Handicap accessible parking is located in front of the church.

## Where do my children go?

When you know your children are in a loving and safe environment you can relax, allowing you to focus on worship and Bible study. Sunday School is available during the 9 AM service. Your children are welcome to all worship services. We have Children's Time, followed by Children's Church, during the Sunday services. Childcare is provided during each service at our nursery.

## Where do I go?

St. Andrew is a growing and we are excited that you are considering visiting with us in person. We would like to personally greet you and help you and your family find your way on your first visit.

We have official greeters every Sunday. You will be greeted at the church entry and welcomed in the sanctuary before the service ends. If you are interested in Bible Study please join us at 9 AM each Sunday.

If you prefer dressy, business, or casual attire, chances are there will be others dressed much like you no matter when you visit.
