Ill. Tom L. Higgins, 33° 09/25/1946-04/28/2021

It is with great sadness that we report the unexpected passing of Ill. Tom L. Higgins, 33°. Tom passed away Wednesday, April 28, 2021 due to non-COVID related health issues.

Tom was the Personal Representative and Chairman of the Executive Committee for the Valley of El Paso from August 22, 2012 until his passing. He served on the Board of Directors for the El Paso Scottish Rite Foundation, Trustee for the Texas Scottish Rite Hospital in Dallas and Trustee for the Texas Scottish Rite Foundation. He was born to Dan and Pauline Higgins on September 25, 1946, and was raised in Canyon, Texas. A masonic service was held at the Scottish Rite Auditorium in El Paso on May 6th, 2021.

Tom graduated from Canyon High School in 1965. He was a proud member of the 1964 state winning Canyon Eagles basketball team. Both Dan and Pauline proudly worked at WT. Tom, along with his father, saw the first WT basketball game in the "Box" and the first football game in Kimbrough Stadium. He spent his school years attending WT athletic events and remained a huge Buffalo Sports fan his entire life. Tom was recruited, and signed, to play basketball for WT. While at WT he pledged the Phi Delta Theta Fraternity and later became president of the Texas Theta Chapter. He was a loyal and active "Phi Delt" throughout his life. Tom worked with the Heflin Foundation to build the beautiful Texas Theta Lodge on 4th Avenue in Canyon, Texas. He graduated from WT in 1971 and enjoyed a successful career in the apparel business and commercial advertising. Tom was a member of the Masonic Lodge #730 in Canyon and Lodge #130 in El Paso. He was very proud that he worked with his father who led the building of the Masonic Lodge #730 in Canyon.





Ill. Fred E. Haller, 33° 04/14/1939-05/12/2021

The El Paso Scottish Rite is saddened to report the passing of Ill. Fred E. Haller, 33° on May 12, 2021. Fred passed while under care in a hospice facility due to long-term health issues. His passing was not COVID related. He retired from teaching and coaching from the El Paso Independent School District.

Fred was a Past Master of Five Points Lodge # 1137 in El Paso, TX. He held a lifetime certificate from the Committee on Work of the Grand Lodge of Texas and served for many years as the District Instructor of Masonic District #60A.

Fred was a member of the El Paso Scottish Rite and served as General Secretary from July 2007 to January 2011. He was knighted as a 32° KCCH on November 21, 2005 and was Coroneted a 33° Inspector General Honorary on November 14, 2009 by the Supreme Council of the Scottish Rite. Fred was also a Shriner with El Maida Shrine in El Paso, TX.
