

10. Walkers in the Dining Room: **Residents with walkers are not following the rules which say no walkers in the dining room. Solution: Park your walker in the Back Dining Room. Your caregiver can do that for you. If you have no caregiver, ask a table-mate to assist you in parking/retrieving your walker. Do not ask the servers. Reason for rule: (1) passersby can easily trip on the protruding wheels etc., (2) the servers cannot maneuver the aisles with carts or loaded hands with items.**
11. Daily calendars posted by elevators: They are not being changed each day. The question was who is responsible.
12. Which lights to turn off: **Lights in the common areas are to be left on. That would include the Library, the MPR, the back dining room. Bathroom lights and Laundry lights are to be turned off.**
13. Back Dining Room refrigerator: **Hoarders are emptying the stock within one day. If you see someone taking more than one item, please report them to Management. Notice to Hoarders: There is no need to take more than one – it will be refilled as often as needed.**
14. Toilet paper: We have had to deal with poor quality toilet paper forever. **TIP: grasp the roll with one hand and yank hard the piece you intend to use. It will break at the perforation...most of the time.**
15. Exercise Room scale: It needs cleaning and possible recalculating. Also it needs a simple walker to place over the stand for balance.
