Guiding Question

How can a new view of existing data in Impact TN enhance our decision-making as educators and leaders?



History & Overview

- Impact TN (Tennessee Educator Dashboard) began as a proposed initiative in the Race to the Top application. Teachers, principals, and other leaders often voiced a need to see data in one portal with fewer logins.
- Dashboards are to be a "one stop shop" for student data and information.
- TENNESSEE SUCCEEDS District Empowerment
- Strategy C. Simplify access to and usability of state-provided technology platforms and tools that support and automate district work.
 - Real-time educator dashboards providing 360 -degree views of student data
 - Single sign-on access and increased automation for state applications and reporting systems
 - Platforms for secure information sharing and collaboration statewide

Purpose of Impact TN

- Data Visualization Tool
 - Data from SIS is transferred to EdFi for Impact TN.
 - Data in EIS does not transfer directly to Impact TN.
- Opportunity to improve data accuracy/quality
- Not designed to be an accountability tool but can provide insight into accountability metrics such as Chronic Absenteeism.
- Version 1.0+ with more versions to follow



Timeline Information

- After September 15, 2017, Impact TN data rollover to 2017-18 will occur.
- September 2017 Teacher Focus Groups will provide feedback on Impact TN.
- No changes are planned for Impact TN at this time.








School View - Academic Dashboard (Default View)









 No new data is generated.
- Demographics and directory Information—district, school, student
- Attendance by grading period, day, and class
- Discipline Issues
- Grades by grading period
- State assessment data
 - Scale Scores for 2015 in 3-8
 - Proficiency Scores for 2016 in High School

Data Validation

Data Quality

"There can be no tolerance for faulty data. That the data is mostly accurate brings no comfort to students or their parents."



Types of Data Quality Issues (Not Inclusive)

- Incorrect enrollment
- Incorrect demographics
- Incorrect "directory" information (name, address, phone, etc.)
- Incorrect transcript grades
- Double/multiple entries for one student


When students, parents, educators, and partners have the right information to make decisions, students excel.
