Insurance Information: Every person should have received a copy regarding Little League Insurance at registration. Please keep a copy for yourself. In the case of an injury, it should be reported to your coach and the league within 24 hours. Volunteer Forms: All parents who help in the dugout or on the field (on a regular basis) **MUST** fill out a Little League Volunteer Application and provide copy of driver's license for basic background check. Please have the appropriate people complete the forms and return them to Heidi Tarbet as soon as possible. 3 forms are enclosed, if you need more, they can be downloaded off the CDO LL website. (Manager and Coaches are already on file)

Opening Ceremonies: Friday March 9th @ 6PM. Players should be in FULL uniform and report to field 5 no later than 5:30 for the team parade. Special Opening Ceremonies dinners are offered through the snack bar. Enclosed are order forms. Please make sure player's families are aware of this offered event. (It's always a fun time to stay and watch the Majors play!)

Little League Patches: Patches will be given at the same time of distribution of uniforms. All patches should be SEWN on the left sleeve approximately 1" down from the top seam. All players should have the patch on their uniforms by the 2nd week of game play.
