Some fun facts:


- They enjoy hiking and look forward to exploring the trails around Central New York.

Gift of Alonzo Peck and Family

Alonzo Peck, son of Josiah and Elizabeth Peck, was primarily a business man. Pecksport, named for his family, was an important point for shipping agricultural products on the Chenango Canal. This location had a cheese factory, storehouses, an ice house, and a milk station. Mr. Peck had storage space on Eaton Street. In addition, he owned large tracts of land in the area. He was one of the founders of the Bank in 1853 and became a vice president in 1865.

Mrs. Sophie Peck Smith donated the money for this beautiful window.
