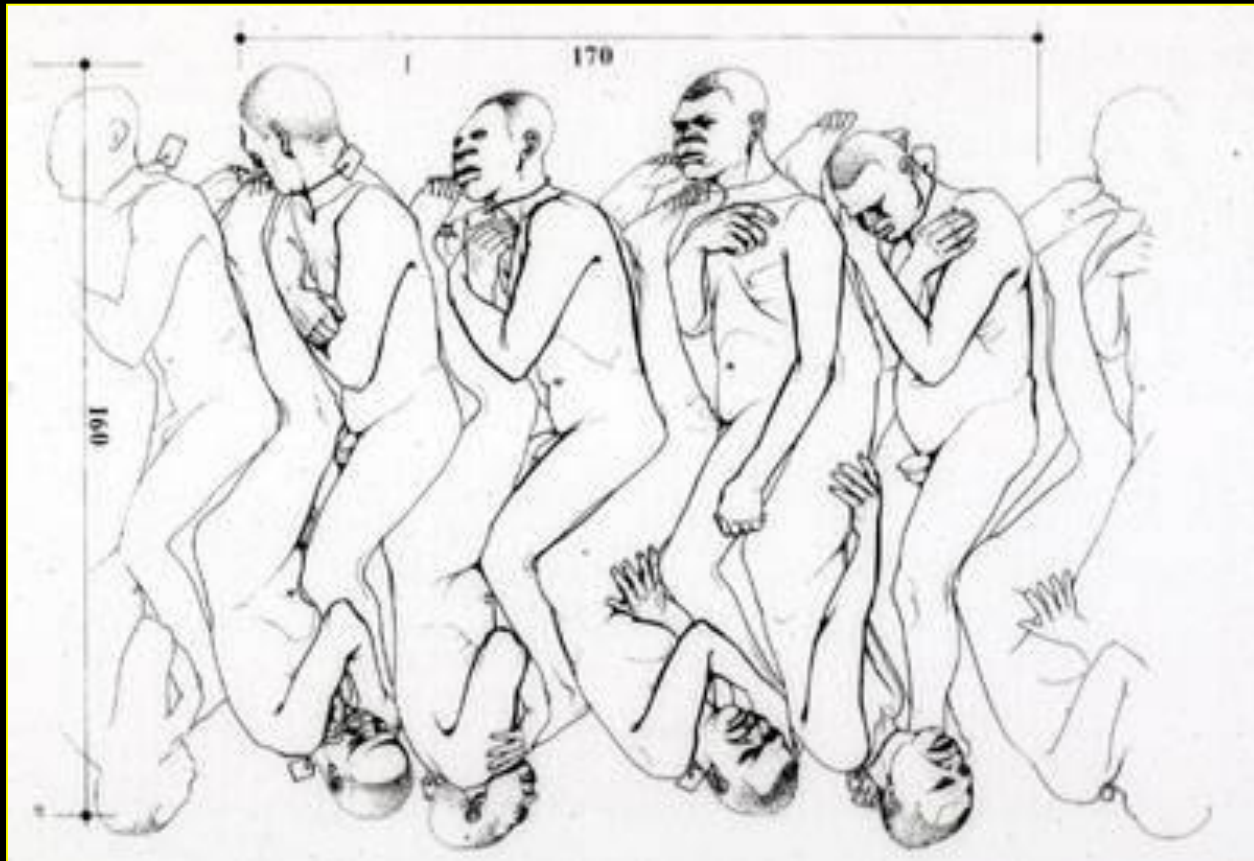


Slave Ship Plan

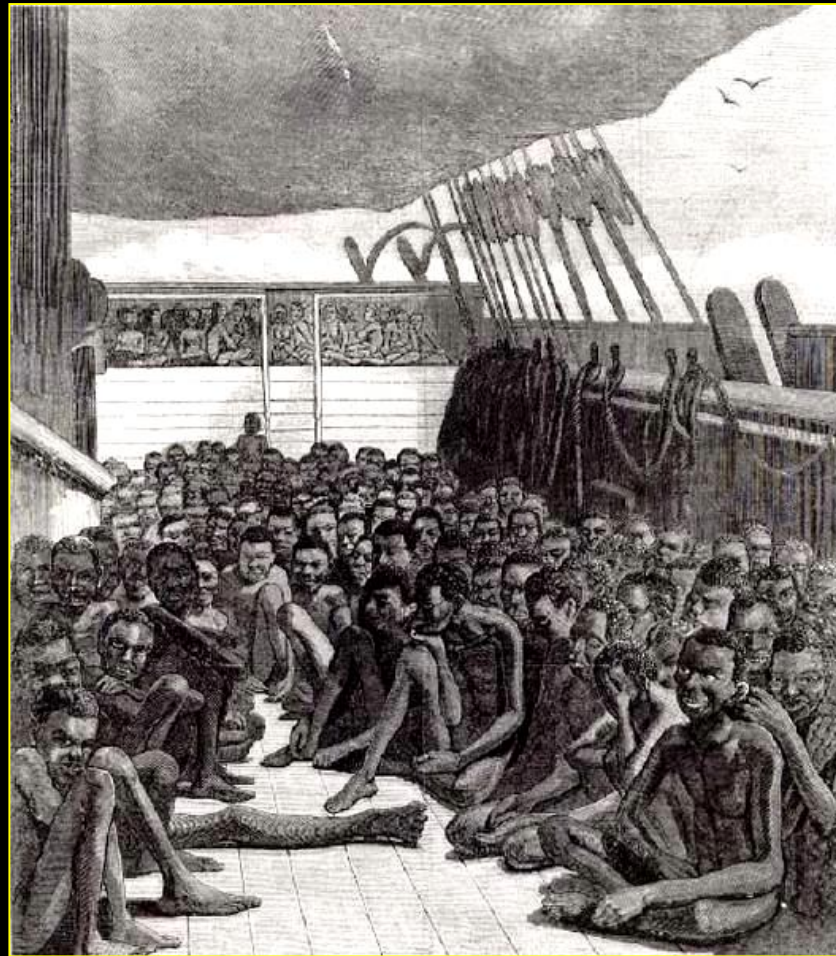
“Coffin” Position: Onboard a Slave Ship



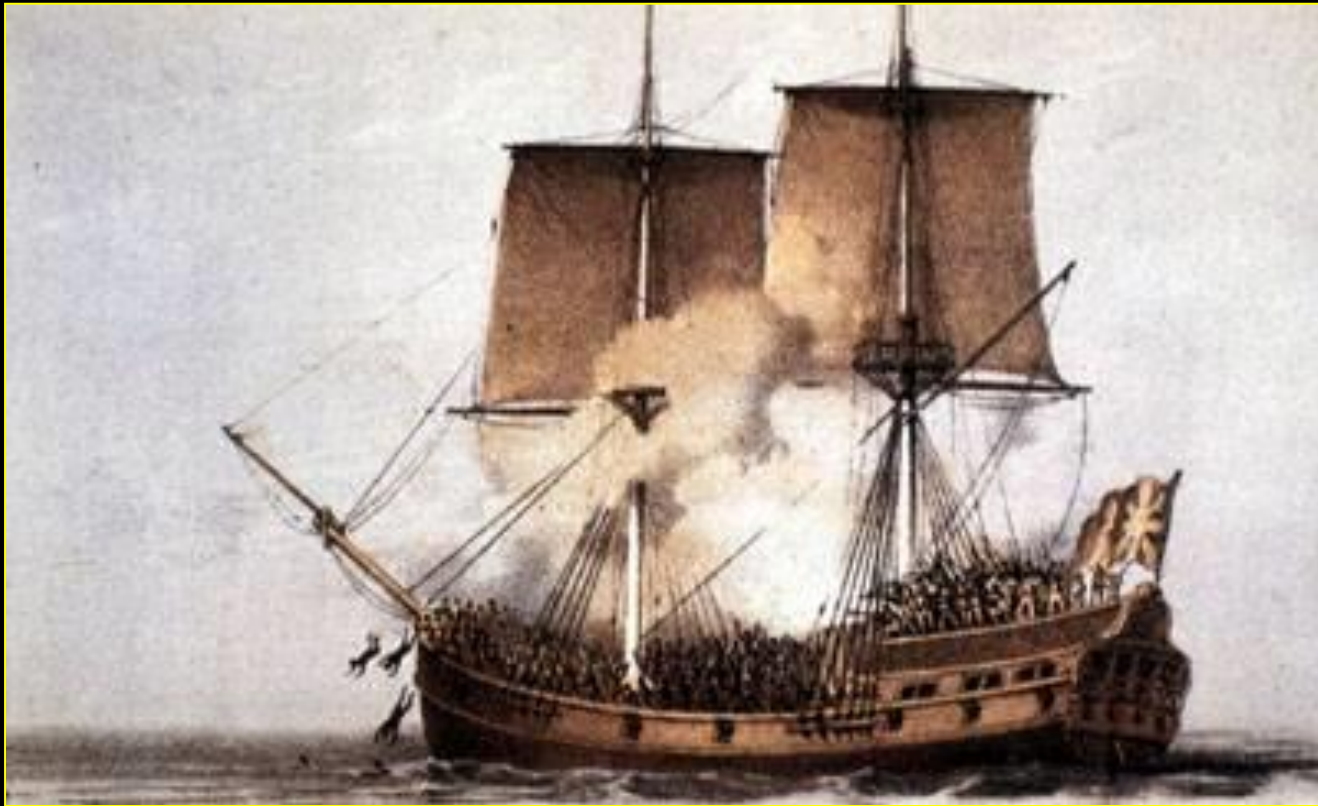

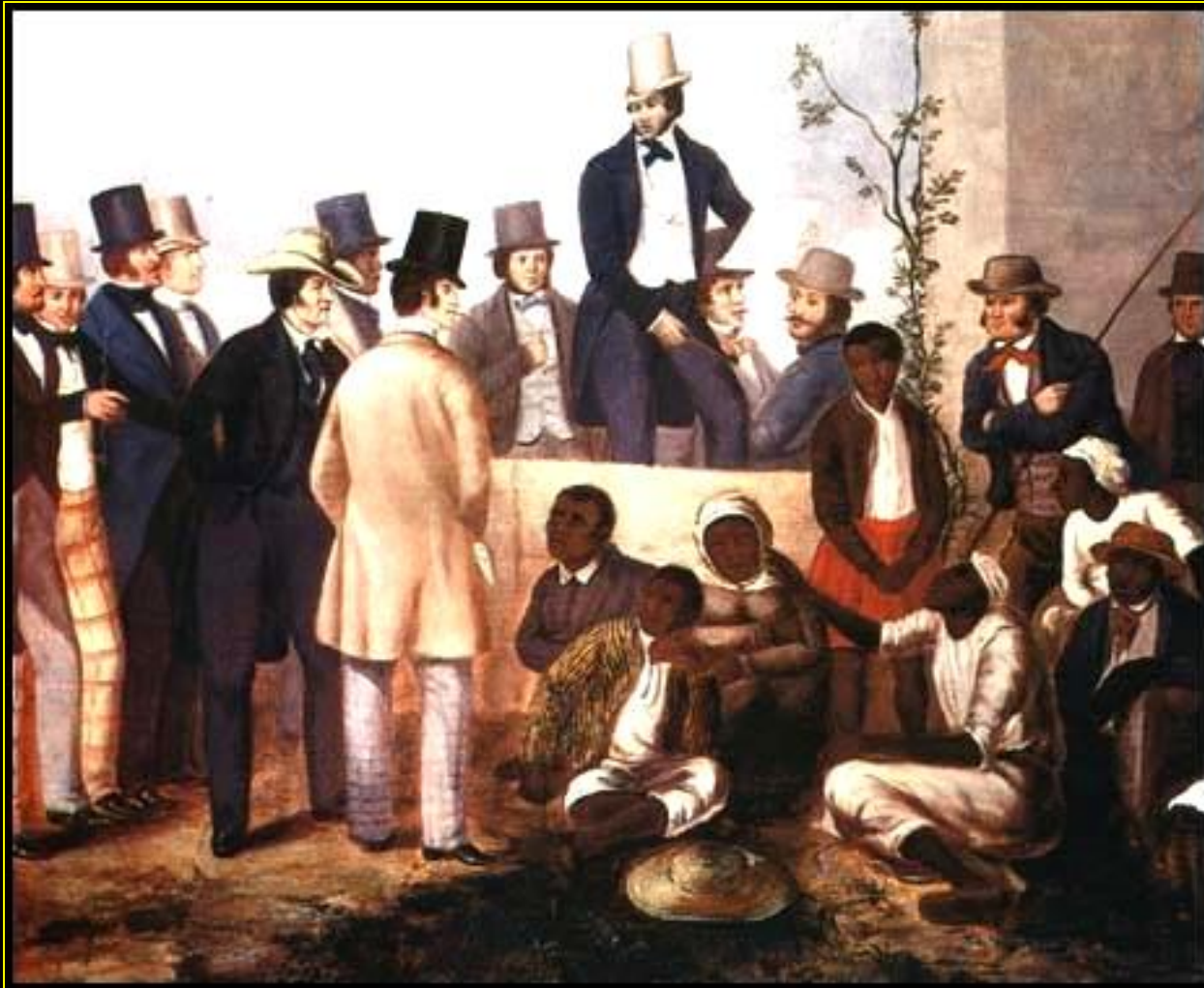

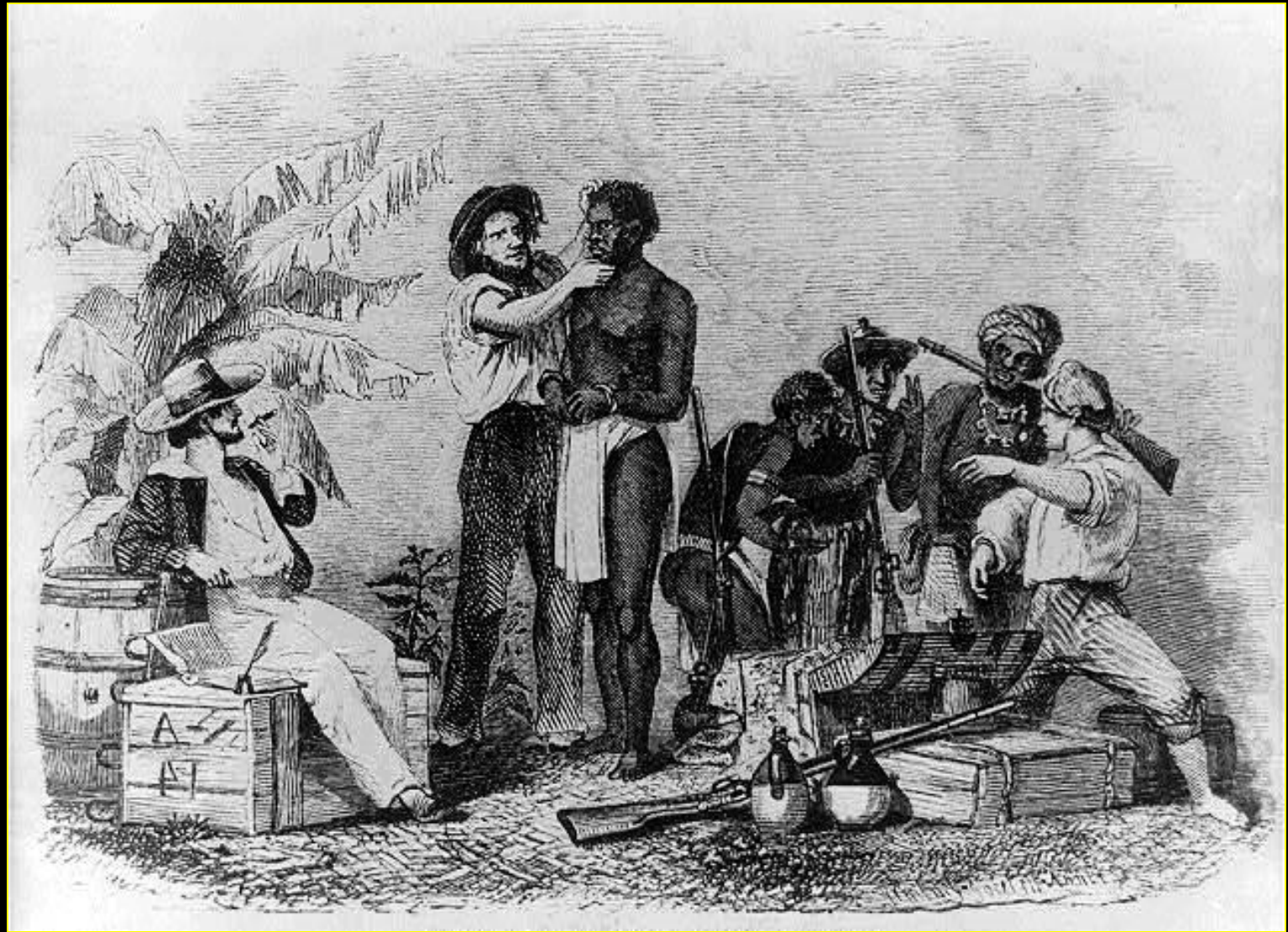

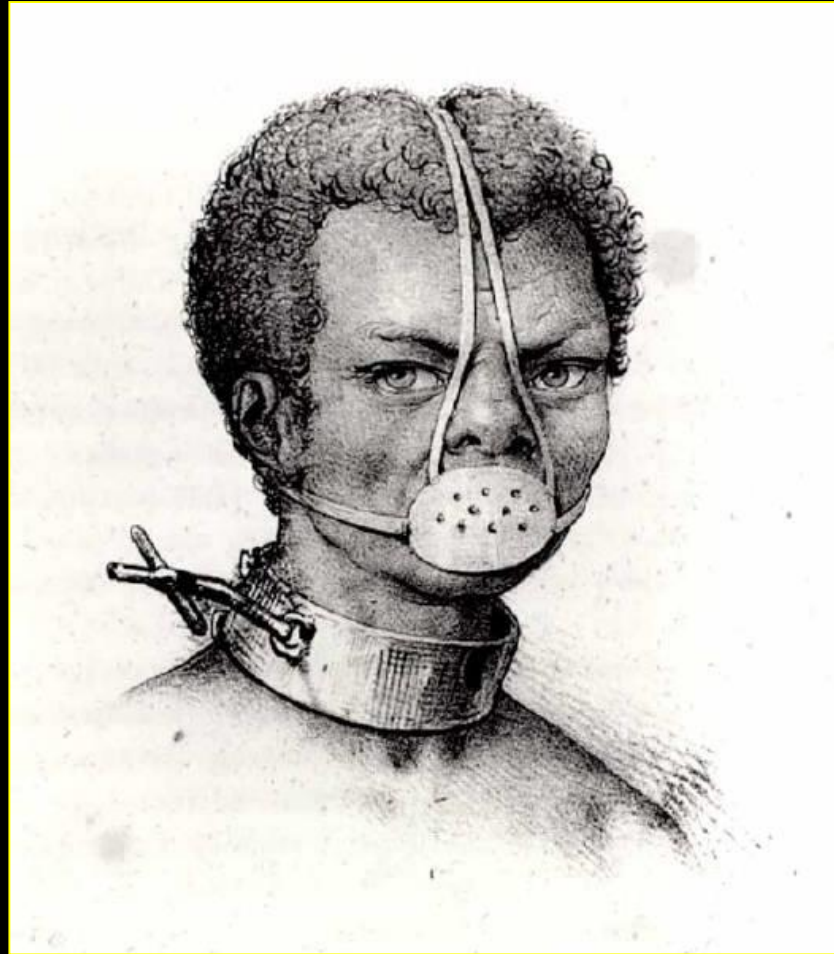

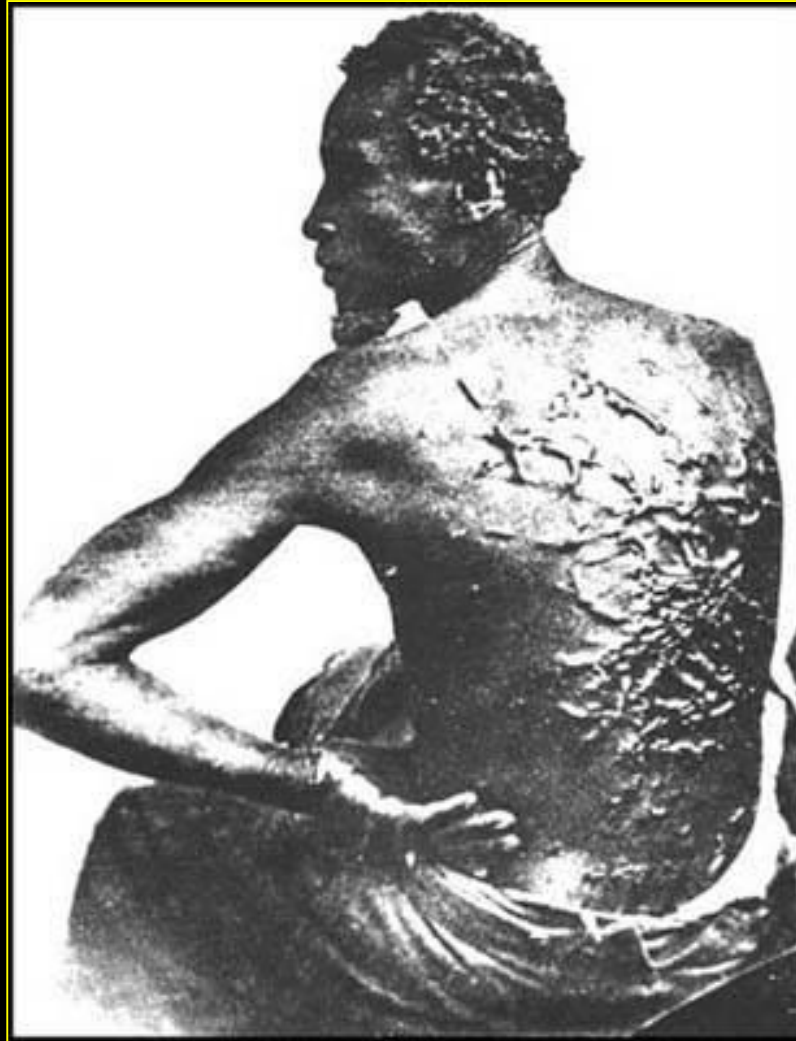

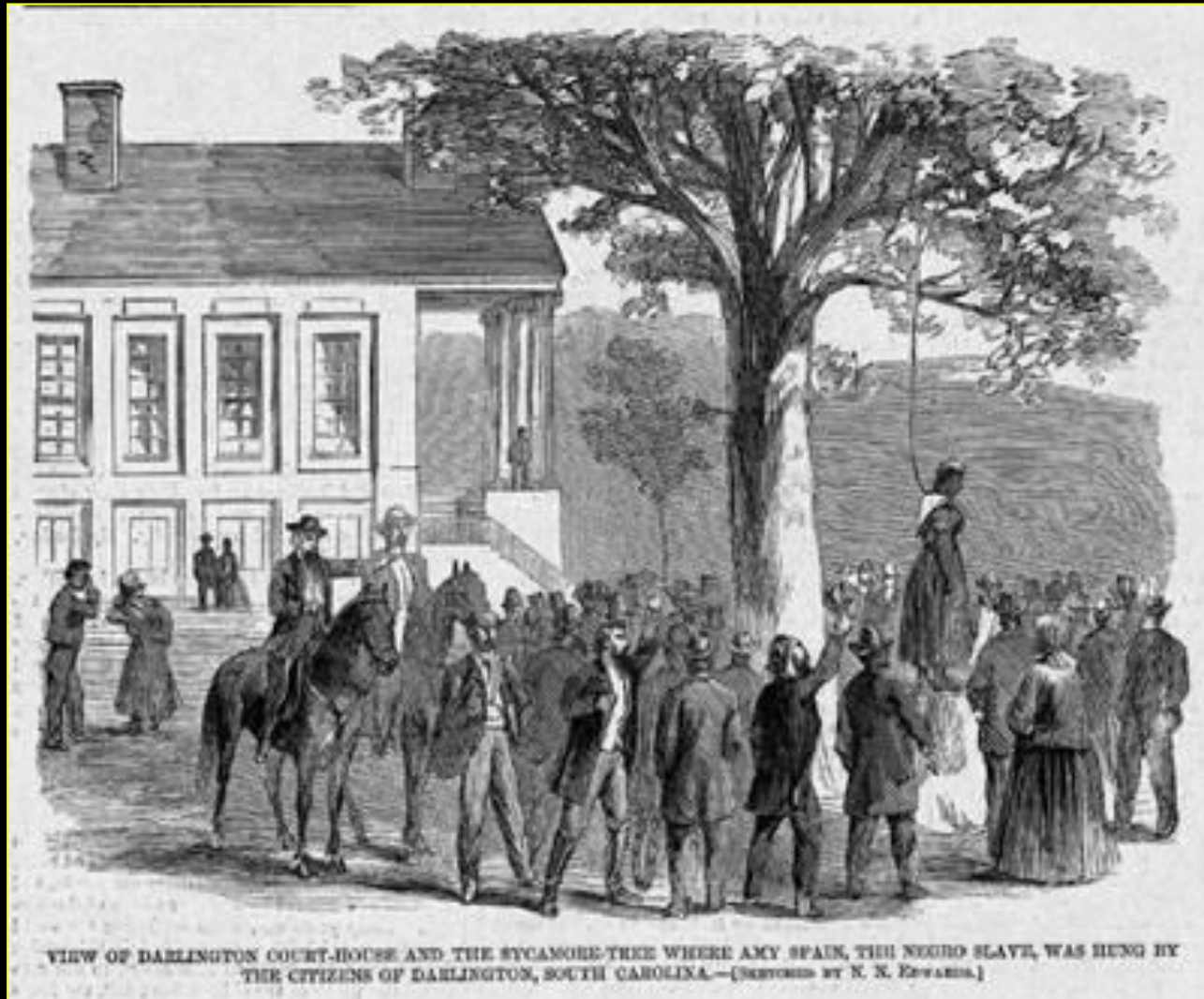
