Baby Bottle Ministry Checklist

The Baby Bottle Ministry is very easy to implement. We can deliver your bottles to you, and then pick them up at the end of the term set.

It works best as a one-month ministry when you follow these important steps:

- ★ Choose a "Point Person" or liaison to head up the ministry at your site
- ★ Determine the number of bottles needed. (Same as number of bulletins printed or one or two per family unit.)
- ★ Choose a start date and an end date four or five weeks later.
- ★ Contact the Pregnancy Help Center (615-281-8054) at least one month prior to your start date to order bottles.
- ★ Plan for "pulpit" announcements and promotion in weekend bulletins and newsletters two weeks in advance
- ★ Place the bottles in visible, convenient locations and assign a small team to help pass them out.
- ★ Post collection reminders each week before end date.

Take a bottle to work with you, and encourage your employers to support the Baby Bottle Ministry and the Pregnancy Help Center of Smith County!


