BYLAW NO. 5 – 2010

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF PREECEVILLE TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 3 – 1982 KNOWN AS THE ZONING BYLAW

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Preeceville in the Province of Saskatchewan, in an open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

- 1. Bylaw No. 3 1982 is amended in the manner hereinafter set forth.
- 2. Part 2 Definitions is amended by adding the following:

<u>Shed</u> – shall mean a building 100 square feet or less used for the purpose of storage.

- Part 5B R Residential District, section (5) Regulations, subsection A. Lot Requirements, Part b) Semi-detached and Duplex Dwellings is amended in the following manner:
 - a) By changing the Lot Depth minimum to 19 meters (63 ft.)
- Part 5B R Residential District, section (5) Regulations, subsection A. Lot Requirements, Part c) Multiple Unit Dwellings is amended in the following manner:

a) By changing the Yard, side – minimum to 1.2 meters (4 ft.)

5. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect from and after the day of final passing thereof.
