THEME: Option 1: Interpretive Art & Interpretive Poetry. The work from poets and artists will be featured in a book about the exhibit. The "existing artworks" submitted for the book will not be considered for the awards. Only new interpretive pieces will be eligible for an award. We currently have 12 artists and 12 poets participating. Entries for this part of the show are closed due to print deadlines.

How Option 1 Works:

1. Participating Artists will each submit 1-3 exiting pieces of art to the Poet they are assigned.
2. Each participating Poet will submit 1-3 poems to the artists they are assigned.
3. Poets and Artists will each choose **one** of these works to create an interpretive piece. All participating Artists and Poets must submit work in electronic format. This will result in 24 pieces of art and 24 poems. Each piece of art will be shown next to its corresponding poem in the book and in the show and vice versa. The books will be for sale at the reception along with the pieces of art. More specific instructions will be sent periodically via email.

THEME: Option 2: Artists will create an interpretive piece based on a poem of their choice. The poem or excerpt from the poem will be read at the reception. These works will not be included in the book due to copyright laws on poetry.

AWARDS: There will be ribbon awards for all interpretive artworks from both options. Existing artworks from option 1 will not be considered.

JURY/JUDGE: The Rogues Jury will jury the entries. Judge TBD.

RECEPTION: There will be a live reading of the poems at the reception. Refreshments will be served. Please contact Julie San Felipe, CelticCow@aol.com , if you are bringing something.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to any Rogues' Artists Group member. Paintings, sculpture, artists' books,

assemblage, photography, metalwork, collage, jewelry are all welcome.

LIABILITY: Submission of an application form constitutes the agreement to all conditions listed in this prospectus. Total number of pieces needed is 40 – 45. Donations for auction benefitting Inspiration Studios are also requested.(tax deductible).

- All art must be original. Compositions from published material, other artist's work or from photographs not taken by the artist are not considered original works.
- 2-D pieces must be properly wired, framed and ready to hang. No saw tooth hangers.
- There are pedestals for 3-D work.
- Size limit: 24" x 48". Weight not to exceed 30 lbs.
- Please attach label with name, title, medium, size and sale price to back of each final submission. No contact info, please.
- Packaging will be taken home at delivery to gallery.

SALES: All artwork must be for sale. All artwork and book sales will be handled by the Gallery. 25% commission on art will be paid to Inspiration Studios.

ENTRY PROCESS:

1. Complete the online application form located on the Rogues Artists website, www.roguesgallery.online. Click on the logo to access the form.
2. Winners will be announced at the reception.
