Both the Rainbow River & the Withlacoochee River feed Lake Rousseau, a 3,657 acre primarily Bass fishing lake, where the fishing is excellent year round! If you want to catch a great variety of fish, you're going to love this 12 mile long stumpy lake, rich with native vegetation and natural cover.

From the City Boat Ramp you must travel 10 miles S or 4 miles W to the nearest boat ramps on the Withlacoochee.

The Withlacoochee State Trail will provide hikers, bikers & roller bladers with an awesome hike or ride on Dunnellon's section of the State of Florida's "Rails to Trails" adventure. Outdoor enthusiasts may also access the Cross-Florida Trail at the Pruitt Head Trailhead.

The clean tea-colored water of the Withlacoochee River is the result of tannic acid produced by the 1000's of acres of cypress & oak trees that densely populate the shores of this magnificent wilderness river.

Halpatz Tastanaki Preserve, Named after the Seminole Leader also known as "Chief Alligator". The preserve, accessed from Pruitt Trailhead, showcases a variety of plant communities from flood-plain swamp & Oak scrub to Longleaf Pine & Turkey Oak sandhills, home to the threatened Florida Scrub Jay.
