For the 20% category the patient will be responsible for 20% of the bill or \$25.00, whichever is higher.

To determine the percentage of the bill the patient is responsible for:

1. Match the number reported living at home with the "number in household" category above;
2. Move across the scale until the yearly income corresponds with the income category;
3. Look at the top of the column to the percentage listed. This percentage is the percentage the patient is responsible for. (EX:S.F. 40% patient pays 40% of the bill.)
4. All household income is to be included. Income is the **AMOUNT EARNED BEFORE DEDUCTIONS.**
