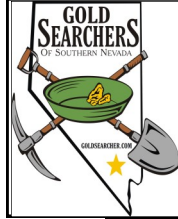
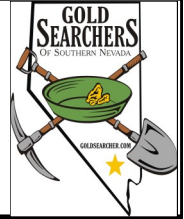

Minutes 02/03/2016
