- We will continue to receive Eucharist Communion under one Species (The Body of Christ).

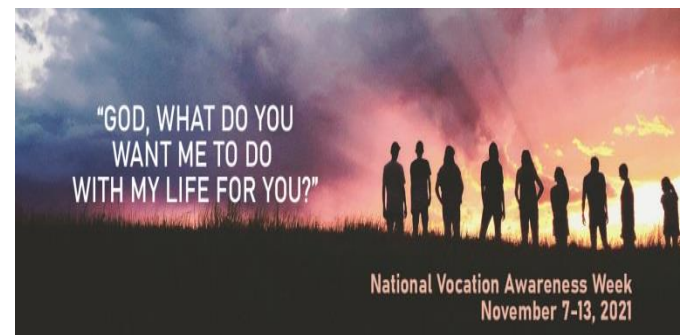

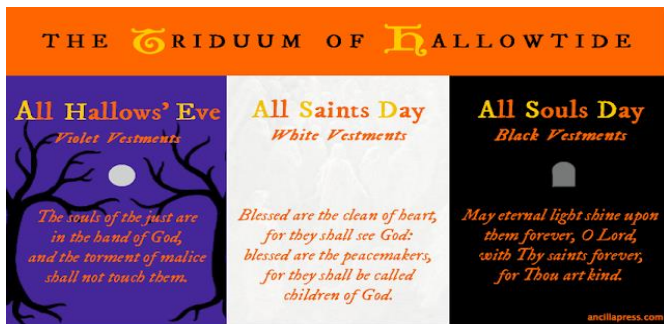
VOCATION AWARENESS WEEK (Nov 7th – 13th)
