Thank you for signing up for our Strawberry Farm Tours! We're excited to have you and your students come to learn about our farm. We strongly believe in educating young children on agriculture and where their food comes from.

Prior To Your Trip:

- Please give us a call two or three days ahead of your scheduled trip if your number of students, chaperones, or parents has changed. **Knowing the number of parents helps us determine how many wagons we need to run, so this number is important to us!*

Where Should We Come?

- Our strawberry fields are on the left and right after you pull into the entrance. Please park the buses in the grassy area closer to the tree line.

How Do We Pay?

- We accept cash, checks, and credit cards. But, we strongly encourage you to pay for your field trip with a school or personal check.
- If you need an invoice for your school, please call or email us ahead of time and we will send you one.
- We encourage you to pay prior to your field trip, you can mail payments to:

- If you want to pay the day of, please have payment ready for ease of our bookkeeper.
- We want to spend time with your children, not collecting payment!

What Should You Do Upon Arrival?

- Please arrive 10-15 minutes prior to the start of your field trip so we can ensure that your group starts on time.

- Please encourage all parents to arrive early as well to give them a chance to purchase their baskets if they would like to pick strawberries. **We will not delay field trips due to late parents or chaperones.*
- Please have ALL parents and chaperones go straight to the field, there is no charge for them unless they want to pick strawberries. *If any parent or chaperone wants to pick strawberries, they will pay for them by the pound (\$2.79/pound).*
- Head to the U-Pick field, the instructor will be there to greet you!

Things to Remember:

- Encourage your students to wear sunscreen that day, we will be in the sun!
- You may want to bring some hand sanitizer for before lunch.
- Remember, you're coming to a farm! Rubber boots and light jackets are never a bad idea!
- If you brought your bagged lunches, please feel free to eat and hang out for a while!
