Water Rates effective January 1, 2018

Inside Village \$50 minimum up to 3,000 gallons \$7.50 per 1,000 gallons over 3000
Outside Village \$60 minimum up to 3,000 gallons \$9.37 per 1,000 gallons over 3,000

Sewer Rates effective January 1, 2018

Village \$30.00 minimum up to 3,000 gallons of water usage, \$6.00 per 1,000 gallons over 3000 gallons of water usage
Water and Sewer bills can be paid on-line, check the Village website.

Tax bills are mailed May 30, 2018 Final date to make a payment locally is November 30th. Please call the office at 532-9200 if you need help with penalty configurations.

Sidewalk Repair Program

Sidewalks are done on worst first basis
The Department of Public Works will tear out the old sidewalk
The DPW has forms to borrow
The DPW will supply stone for the base
The home owner hires the contractor with approval of DPW and Village Board
The Contractor forms the site, pours the concrete, takes off the forms and cleans up forms. The DPW will then put dirt and grass seed along edges and straw
All forms must be inspected by Department of Public Works before concrete is poured.
All sidewalks are four feet wide by 4" thick — with reinforcing wire, 6" thick at driveways. Concrete is fibered
Concrete is billed to the Village, 3500 pounds minimum

**Brush, Grass, Weeds
Accumulation of Trash**

No owner or occupant of any real property located within the Village of Interlaken shall allow such real property to become overgrown with brush, grass or weeds, six inches or higher, or allow the unlawful accumulation of rubbish or trash.

It shall be the duty of the owner or occupant of any real property located within the Village of Interlaken to cut, trim and remove any such brush, grass or weeds thereon and to remove any accumulation of rubbish or trash thereon.

Sump Pumps and Guttering

It is against the Law for property owners or tenants to have their sump pump and/or gutter drains run into the municipal sewer drains. Discharge into the storm drains is acceptable. Inspections will be made as needed.
