Areas of south central Missouri received from 10 to around 12 total inches of rainfall. This resulted in widespread and historic flooding. Numerous roads, bridges and buildings were destroyed. Many roads were flooded through the event including state highways and Interstate 44 and Interstate 55 in east central Missouri.

Catholic Charities of Central and Northern Missouri have been involved in initial relief efforts. Numerous households throughout the Diocese of Jefferson City have been impacted by these floods and will need both short and long-term assistance in their recovery efforts.

In response to those needs a second collection for the weekend of June 10-11 has been approved. If donations are made by check, please make it out to IC Parish with "Flood Relief" in the memo field. All funds collected will be sent to Catholic Charities of Central and Northern Missouri.
