Corridor MPO Solicits Input on Connections 2040 Amendment for Hwy. 100 Extension Project

CEDAR RAPIDS, IA – **June 17, 2011** – The Corridor Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) seeks public input on amending the Fiscally Constrained Plan of Connections 2040 (long-range transportation plan). The Fiscally Constrained Plan is the budgeted list of transportation improvements (roadway, trail, transit) over the next 30-years that will help make the metropolitan area more attractive for people and businesses.

The Highway 100 Extension project includes the construction of the highway from Edgewood Road NW to Covington Road and the environmental, right-of-way, and grading work for the highway from Covington Road to Highway 30. This project has recently received funding from the Iowa DOT Transportation Commission.
