A MESSAGE FROM WALK #187 SPIRITUAL DIRECTOR

My original walk was Blue Lake Women's Walk To Emmaus # 12, that took place in 1987. I know that as we gather together for our team meetings for CAEW #187, the Holy Spirit will bring together the many pieces of our team, and a whole team will become one, as we join together with the pilgrims, on "the best walk ever".

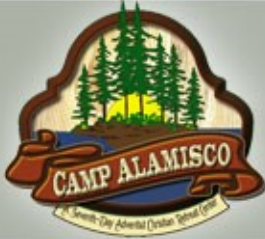
