The election results are in. The new Donald Trump administration takes over on January 20, 2017. There will be new political appointees at the Department of the Interior. As leaders, you need to know their backgrounds and agendas for the Federal Public Lands agencies.

A Republican House of Representatives and a Republican Senate will control the 115<sup>th</sup> Congress. New players in both the House and Senate will be assigned to committees with jurisdiction over National Park Service issues and budget.

Federal employees must know about the legislative and budget processes on Capitol Hill that affect their agencies given the austere fiscal climate. Knowledge of these processes will provide participants with the tools to effectively implement federal policy in the field.
