

New Era Hosts the Southern Region of PNBC





The 61st Annual Session for the Southern Region of the Progressive National Baptist Convention was held June 17 - 20, 2024 at The Courtland Grand Hotel in Atlanta GA.

Under the leadership of New Era President, Bishop Rosa L. Williams, it was approved for us to Host the event and provide programming for the Welcome Night that took place on Monday evening June 17, 2024. The Host Committee was Chaired by our First Vice President, Rev. Stanley A. Smith and his committee members were: Second Vice President, Rev. Karen Kelley, Third Vice President, Dr. Antonio Proctor, Rev. Eric Thomas, Dr. Arthur Carson, Jr., Sister Chris Glover, and Sister Selethia D. Smith.

CONVENTION CENTER NEWS

Selethia D. Smith New Era Executive Board Chair



In 1995, negotiations between Mr. and Mrs. Matthew Talmadge, Sr., owner of "T's Recreation Area" and the New Era Missionary Baptist Convention of Ga., Inc. began in regards to 40 plus acres with a building that could accommodate 250 people, a commercial kitchen, a dormitory that could accommodate 42 people, a two acre lake, hiking trails, a swimming pool and other amenities. A site committee was formed with Dr. Cleopatrick Lacy serving as Chair of committee members Dr. John Waters, Sister Rossie Johnson, Rev. Hezekiah Benton, Rev. Hopie Strickland, Jr., Rev. Earl D. Bryant, Rev. James Cantrell, Rev. Adolph Parsons, Sister Barbara Pullin, and Rev. Charles Nesbitt. In 2000, New Era purchased another 49 acres.

Twelve New Era Churches pledged \$1200.00 per year for five years to support the Convention Center. Those churches are: Beluah Baptist Church(Atlanta), Friendship Community Church(College Park), First Baptist Church Fannin Street(LaGrange), Greater Mt. Pleasant Baptist Church(Hapeville), The Greater Solid Rock Baptist Church(Riverdale), Mt. Calvary Baptist Church(Atlanta), Mt. Olive Baptist Church(Stockbridge), Mt. Zion Baptist Church(Griffin), St. James Baptist Church(Forsyth), Second Ebenezer Baptist Church(Savannah), Springfield Baptist Church(Atlanta), West Hunter Street Baptist Church(Atlanta).

Under the leadership of Dr. Douglas E. Stowers, our Convention Center property was paid in full and New Era became the proud owners of the approximately 100 scenic acres which is valued at more than \$1,000,000,000.00 today.

In March 2024 during our Adjourned Session in Forsyth, GA, the report from First VP Rev. Stanley A. Smith and Dea. Lee Kelley introduced information regarding a new construction project to add a Dining Hall with a catering Kitchen to the Main or Multi-purpose building. It was approved by the Executive Board and the Parent Body. Almost immediately, several Pastors gave donations of \$1000.00 to support the project and others made financial pledges to show their support. A Dining Hall is beneficial for the Convention during our meeting dates on the property allowing us to prepare food and eat without disrupting services or other programming that may be taking place in our main building as well as making our property a revenue-generator. There have been several organizations who have and will be gathering on our property this year for a Missions Retreat, a Youth Boys Group outing, our Congress of Christian Education, Church picnics are being planned and we will GROW from there!

We expect to receive drawings of the new Dining Hall and Phase I of the plans in the coming weeks. We need your support. 
