At this time Greg Germain, Project Engineer, began going through the presentation of the Study. Several ideas were discussed and the importance of Council and Residents putting these infrastructure projects as identified by ISL Engineering into a realistic and practical order of completion. Some of the areas of concern were:

Public Works Building;

- Lift Station Wet-Well refurbishment or replacement;
- Water Station capacity;
- Fire Hydrants;
- Sidewalk repair;
- Re-lining sewer pipes throughout the Village.

These decisions need to be made by both residents and council and to do this effectively the 'level of service' needs to be considered in each of these choices.

Several questions were put forward by the residents at the meeting as well as council. At approximately 8:05 the questions were asked and answered.

Wei Ming Chew, Project Manager, Greg Germain, Project Engineer and Jennifer Esler, Community Engagement Specialist, left the Teams Meeting at 8:08 p.m.

After the Engineers left the meeting Council stayed and spoke to residents for some time.
