

## SUN LAKES SENIOR SOFTBALL ASSOCIATION POLICY REGARDING NON-RESIDENT PLAYERS

It is the policy of the SLSSA to allow a limited number of non-resident players to participate in the Association. The objective is to provide additional players in order to field a minimum of six teams for league play and to improve the level of competition.

1. Per the Bylaws of the SLSSA, the number of non-resident players may not exceed 25% of the total membership.
2. Non-residents are defined as anyone who does not live in a Sun Lakes or Sunbird community.
3. Residents include homeowners, seasonal residents and renters living in Sun Lakes and Sunbird.
4. Non-resident players must be sixty years old or older to participate. The age test is based upon the actual birth date of the player.
5. These rules apply to league play, the Monday program and the summer play program.
6. The age limit does not apply to the Ladies' team; however, the 25% rule does apply.
7. This policy is effective as of October 9, 2009 and does not apply to players who were a part of the program prior to that date.
