REQUEST FROM MARK GIBSON

Dear BEC Family,

As many of you know, I spend a chunk of my time working with the Fulani church in Burkina Faso and am in constant contact with the Fulani church leaders out there and I get needs presented to me on a regular basis and often need great wisdom on what I present to the church and what I don't.

With the increased challenges the church faces in Burkina and the ongoing deterioration communication is increasing being done via phone both within the country and outside to the likes of myself.

One of the problems is, the mobile phones available in Burkina often have a very short shelf life (6 month to a year). Original phones (that aren't knock offs) are at such a high price that they are unaffordable for our guys. For the Fulani church leaders these are not luxury items, they have become an essential part of how they operate in the changing world they find themselves in.

My hope is to be able to take out two or three smart phones when I have meetings with the church leaders in September this year.

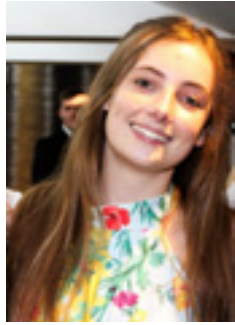
