

March is National Colorectal Cancer Awareness Month Life Line Screening will be offering preventive health screenings on Thursday, March 9, 2023. As part of the screening event, Life Line Screening will offer low-cost take-home colorectal cancer tests called FIT (Fecal Immunochemical Test) in recognition of March as Colorectal Cancer Awareness Month. These tests are simple, accurate, and recommended for the early detection of colorectal cancer. According to the Centers for Disease Control, the risk of developing colorectal cancer increases with age. More than 90% of cases occur in people aged 50 and older. Pre-registration is required.

A Devotional For You – Read John 1:43-51

So, I feel a little bad about "leaving out" one of the Apostles from the recent sermon series on *The Chosen* ... Nathaniel (or "Bartholomew" as he's names in the lists of the Apostles in the other Gospels). Nathaniel seemed to be Philip's best friend. What I love about Nathaniel is the difference between the things that come out of his mouth. Within FOUR verses, he goes from saying this about Jesus: "Can anything good come from Nazareth?" to ... saying this about Jesus: "Rabbi, you are the Son of God – the King of Israel!" WOW! What happened to change his belief, to change his worldview?! It wasn't a miracle (which helped Peter get to the point of faith – remember the great catch of fish) ... no, it wasn't a spectacle. It was Jesus' knowledge of Nathaniel without ever meeting him. Nathaniel perceived that Jesus "saw him" ... and saw him completely. Probably one thing he saw was Nathaniel's love of God's word in Scripture – the context of John shows that Philip and Nathaniel were aware (and expectant) of the "one prophesied by Moses and the prophets" (v. 45). That's how Philip appealed to his friend, because he knew Nathaniel knew the Old Testament prophecies.

Do you remember how I've talked about the "characteristics" of the disciples that Jesus redeemed and sanctified? [Peter's brashness humbled to a Spirit-driven boldness, James and John's judgmental passion changed to love-motivated zeal, etc.]. In Nathaniel, I see Jesus working on his *prejudice*. Although he had strong spiritual interests and a holy expectation, like many, many "church folk" through the ages, he displayed an all-too-human form of prejudice: "Can anything good come from _____?" His objection was probably based not so much in biblical rationality but biased emotion. Prejudice is ugly, and it's spiritually debilitating ... Most people have prejudices, and a great many of those delude themselves into thinking they don't. But here, again, we see that God takes pleasure in using the common, the flawed, the imperfect things of the world to confound the wise. God, through Christ, can take a person blinded by prejudice, and use him to transform the world.

Jesus saw past Nathaniel's prejudice to his sincerity of heart. [Let me just say: I *really* like the things Jesus sees in us that we often don't]. As Nathaniel approached Jesus (they hadn't even said, "Hello" for the first time yet!), Jesus says, "Behold an Israelite in whom there is no deceit!" Can you imagine a more wonderful thing than to have words of approval like that come to you out of the mouth of Jesus!? And this isn't at the end of Nathaniel's life, in the moment he faced martyrdom, this comes as the prologue. That, my friends, is the power of grace. He may have displayed prejudice, but Nathaniel was no hypocrite (the thing Jesus hated the most); in other words, he worshiped the true and living God without deceit. With how the religious establishment is described in the Gospels, this seems to have been a *rarity*. So, the absence of guile in this young man was beautiful in Jesus' eyes.

Because Jesus fed his faith over the years to follow, the sincerity in his heart overcame his prejudice. The ensuing ministry of Jesus only affirmed what he now knew to be true. Our text ends with Jesus saying to him, "hereafter you will see heaven opened and the angels of God ascending and descending upon the Son of Man." It's of course a reference to Jacob's vision (Gen. 28:12), but the point is – *Jesus* is the ladder. And Nathaniel would see the presence of God and the works of God ascending and descending all around him. And since we're in the season of Lent, we're reminded of the most pivotal place where that happened – where we see most clearly the ladder in Jesus connecting heaven and earth ... the cross. As Jesus "sees" us, may we always see God through him. Amen.






Mark your calendar! The Ordination and Installation of our new Church Officers will be held on April 2, 2023 during the Worship Service.




