ATS Notables

The North Carolina/Appalachian St game went OVER the total by 67.5 points! There were a combined 62 points scored in the fourth quarter alone!

Syracuse won 31-7 as 5.5-point underdogs vs Louisville.

James Madison won 44-7 covering the spread by 32.5-points vs Middle Tennessee.

New Mexico covered the spread by 35 points in a 41-0 win over Maine.

Hawaii has failed to cover the spread by a combined 59.5-points so far this season! The SEC went 13-1 SU and 9-5 ATS.

Say you wanted to steam chase right before kickoff every 3-point or more line move in CFB this year...You are 68-71-3 (48.9%). Similarly, if you somehow had a crystal ball & predicted every line that would move 3 or more points and bet the opening line...You are 95-47 (66.9%).

We bet Texas State +10.5 over Nevada this summer. Texas St closed 2-point favorites. Texas St lost by 24. There are no locks folks!!!

Misleading Finals

Oklahoma St only beat Central Michigan 58-44. However, it should be noted Oklahoma St led 51-15 very early in the 3Q and we saw extended garbage time.

Old Dominion (+6) upset Virginia Tech 20-17. The Monarchs were +3 in TO's. VT had a 333-248 yard edge and also 4.4-3.6 in yards per play.

Indiana (-1) beat Illinois 23-20. However, Illinois had a 453-362 yard edge including 221-32 on the ground. The Illinois had 4 TO's and were stopped on downs twice.

USC blew out Rice 66-14 but the Trojans had not one, not two but three "Pick 6's" all off deflected passes.

Nevada (+2) was +4 in TO's vs Texas St. Nevada won 38-14 despite getting out-gained 277-274.

NC State (-12.5) only won at East Carolina 21-20, thanks to a blocked punt return TD, a missed PAT, and a missed FG on the final play. ECU outgained the Wolf Pack 390-344 and had a 5.7-5.3 ypp edge.

Wyoming (+6.5) upset Tulsa 40-37 in 2 OT. However, it should be noted Tulsa had a 521-399 yard edge. Wyoming got a fumble return TD and a blocked punt TD.

Bad Beats

The total in the Colgate/Stanford game was 51.5. Stanford scored a TD with 3:15 left to make it 41-10. They missed the extra point!

The total in the Western Kentucky/Hawaii game was 67.5. WKU led 49-17 in the final minutes but Hawaii had a 1st & goal at the one-yard line. They had 4 straight runs and couldn't gain a single yard!

-Auburn QB's TJ Finley and Robby Ashford are both expected to play this week.

-Boise St QB Hank Banchmeier was benched last week for Taylen Green. Both took first team reps in practice Monday.

-Charlotte QB Chris Reynolds is questionable vs Maryland this week.

-Colorado QB did not commit to a starter this week after Brendon Lewis and JT Shroat both played last week.

-Connecticut QB Ta'Quan Roberson is out for the season.

-FIU QB Gunnar Holmberg is questionable vs Texas St.

-Iowa QB Spencer Petras is still listed as the starter. Petras had the worst total QBR in a win in the last 10 years!

-Kentucky RB Chris Rodriguez is still suspended for this week's game vs Florida.

-Liberty QB Charlie Brewer will have hand surgery and is expected to be out at least 5 weeks. Johnathan Bennett and Kaidon Salter got snaps last week.

-LSU DL Maason Smith will miss the season after injuring his knee while celebrating.

-Miami, OH QB Brett Gabbert will be out for a while after an upper-body injury occurred late vs Kentucky. Aveon Smith is expected to be the starter.

-Michigan St LB Darius Snow is out for the season while Safety Xavier Henderson could be out for awhile.

-North Carolina WR Josh Downs missed last game with a lower body injury and is questionable this week.

-Notre Dame LG Jarrett Patterson (foot) missed last week's game vs Ohio St and is questionable this week.

-Ohio St WR Jaxon Smith-Njigba is likely to miss a game or two with a mild hamstring injury he suffered against Notre Dame.

-Ole Miss QB Luke Altmyer was confirmed to take the first snaps this week. Last week's starter Jaxon Dart will also play.

-Rutgers QB Noah Vedral missed last week's game and is questionable this week.

-Southern Miss QB Ty Keyes has a chance to play this week after leaving last week's game with injury.

-Syracuse LB Stefan Thompson and TE Chris Elmore are out for the season.

-TCU QB Chandler Morris is out this week with a sprained knee. Max Duggan is expected to start vs Tarleton St.

-Texas Tech QB Tyler Shough will likely be out at least 2-3 weeks (collarbone). Donovan Smith is listed as the starter.

Games in Rotation Order Friday, September 9th

UCF 33 Louisville 27. Scott Satterfield's seat was a little warm entering the season and it grew hot with a 31-7 loss at Syracuse as 5.5-point favorites. The Cardinals are starting at 0-2 vs a UCF team that looks better at QB with John Rhys Plumlee (308 pass, 86 rush). We don't see much value.

Boise St 32 NEW MEXICO 14. Boise disappointed us greatly on these pages last week. In a span of five first-half pass attempts, Broncos QB Hank Bachmeier threw two interceptions and lost a fumble. Oregon St took a 17-0 lead 20 minutes into the game. Meanwhile, New Mexico finally looks like it has taken a step forward under Danny Gonzalez destroying Maine 41-0 as 6-point favorites. We think Boise bounces back and bet them -15 on the openers.

Saturday, September 10th

OHIO ST 56 Arkansas St 10. The Buckeyes offense really sputtered last week vs ND without WR Smith-Njigba who is likely out for this game as well. The good news is the defense looks much improved compared to what it was the last two seasons. Arkansas St's defense also looked improved in their blowout win over Grambling. Slight lean UNDER.

North Carolina 37 GEORGIA ST 28. NC trailed a game by 14 points at one point and also gave up 40 points in the fourth quarter, yet still found a way to win as 3-point underdogs at Appalachian St. QB Drake Maye has been fantastic but the defense has been suspect the first couple of weeks. Georgia St allowed two non-offensive TD's in a non-cover vs South Carolina. Believe it or not, a lot of respected money has come in on the UNDER. We're not involved.

PENN ST 40 Ohio 13. Our numbers have a lean towards Penn St here. The Nittany Lions have a couple extra days to prep after their final minute win at Purdue. Meanwhile, Ohio surprised many including us, with an upset over FAU. Their 2nd-year head coach is in a much better spot than last season. Penn St has Auburn on deck.

ARMY 28 Utsa 27. Keep an eye on this line (currently Utsa -2). We're hearing whispers that Army might be taking some serious money later this week. Our numbers lean that way but we need a "+3" to show up to get involved. Both teams are 0-1 and need a win. UTSA lost in 3OT to in-state Houston and have Texas on deck. A little bit of a sandwich spot.

MIAMI, FL 40 Southern Miss 14. The Mario Cristobal era is off to a great start after the Canes put up 70 vs Bethune-Cookman. Meanwhile, Southern Miss already has QB injury issues (check status for Ty Keyes) after their 4OT loss to Liberty. Miami has Texas A&M on deck so we don't expect a foot on the gas pedal. We bet UNDER with the Southern Miss QB news.

NORTHWESTERN 32 Duke 22. Northwestern comes in off a bye after their upset over Nebraska in Ireland. Meanwhile, Duke was super impressive in a blowout win over Temple. We bet Northwestern -6 on the openers but obviously aren't fans of laying double-digits. We're really surprised the OVER has taken money. Sure, both teams are running some tempo but these are still two defensive-minded head coaches. We like UNDER.

KANSAS ST 32 Missouri 24. These two haven't played in a decade after being long-time rivals. Both teams won and covered vs weaker competition last week. Tough fading the team from the SEC here but our numbers say this line is right.

ARKANSAS 30 South Carolina 22. Both teams won and covered last week. Obviously, Arkansas had stiffer competition vs Cincinnati than South Carolina who played Georgia St. The Gamecocks also benefited from a pair of blocked punts (can you say Beamer Ball?). Another point spread where we the line is dialed in with our numbers (see page 6). We did bet UNDER on the openers.

Alabama 42 TEXAS 23. If the line closes here, it will be the largest home underdog role for Texas since point-spreads were widely available (1976). It is deserved considering Alabama's greatness. We stepped in front of the Elephant last week and got crushed with the Crimson Tide covering a 6-TD spread. Bryce Young looks 10 pounds heavier (in a good way) and surprisingly ran for 100 yards. Meanwhile, Texas had their way with ULM covering a big spread. Our numbers say, Texas is the play but we're not stepping in from of the Tide again. It's Saban vs one of his former assistants and after losing a pair last season for the first time, he re-establishes dominance here. We did love the OVER but it's gotten pricey now.

Wake Forest 39 VANDERBILT 26. The big news here is that Wake QB Sam Hartman will be back for this game. He was originally thought to be out several games. Hartman is worth about 6 points to the spread and we saw the line move 5 points yesterday alone. Vandy is off to a 2-0 start but will be out-classed here.

CENTRAL MICHIGAN 31 South Alabama 26. Kudos to CMU for not giving up after trailing Oklahoma St 51-15 early 3Q. How embarrassing for us to have the UNDER on these pages in that game. Meanwhile, a sharp betting group loves South Alabama this season. They were rewarded with a blowout win over Nicholls last week. We just can't get to the window at the current numbers.

Western Michigan 31 BALL ST 23. WMU gave a good fight vs Michigan St last week. They only trailed 21-13 entering the 4Q. The same can't be said for Ball St who was crushed by Tennessee. We bet WMU -6 on the openers and still like it.

NOTRE DAME 38 Marshall 16. The Marcus Freeman era is off to an 0-2 start albeit ND has played a pair of Top 10 teams away from home. We were super impressed with their defense last week holding Ohio St to 21 points. We believe the Irish will be focused here in the home debut of Freeman who needs a "feel-good" win. Meanwhile, Marshall hasn't played a Power 5 team since 2018.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Maryland 44 CHARLOTTE 20. Charlotte is in really bad shape. The 49ers are 0-2 SU/ATS and have been easily defeated by both FAU and William & Mary. Both of their top 2 QB's are banged up (check status). Maryland can name the score but this does seem a little pricey. We bet UNDER 70.5 on the openers in case Charlotte is down to a 3rd-string QB and has a limited playbook.

3★ Tennessee 38 PITTSBURGH 29. We love Tennessee here. This is a good match-up for them. The way to beat Pitt's press coverage defense is a bunch of vertical routes down the field and Tennessee will do that plenty. The Vols have revenge for losing to Pitt last year. In that game, then-QB Joe Milton couldn't hit open receivers, we think Hendon Hooker will. We were shocked Pitt got out-classed at the line of scrimmage vs West Virginia last week. Meanwhile, Tennessee could've spent much of fall camp on this game after playing lowly Ball St.

Memphis 30 NAVY 22. Seems like a "buy low" spot for Navy after losing to an FCS team last week. The problem is Navy just isn't that good anymore. Without a difference maker like Malcolm Perry or Keenan Reynolds under center, they are a losing program. How about a 7-16 SU in their last 23 games? We bet Memphis -6 on the openers.

AIR FORCE 32 Colorado 16. We bet Colorado UNDER their season win total. We bet Air Force OVER their season win total and it was one of our favorite bets. However, we can't get our ratings to this point-spread. Honestly if Colorado head coach Karl Dorrell can't cover this kind of number in Year 3 vs an in-state "little brother" we think his days will be numbered.

TEXAS A&M 37 Appalachian St 17. Seems like a decent spot to play against Appalachian St after such an emotional performance last week vs North Carolina. How do you lose a game when you at one point lead by 14 and also score 40 points in the 4Q? Meanwhile, A&M had to sit through a lengthy weather delay vs Sam Houston St but got a nice 31-0 win. We bet the Aggies and the OVER on the openers.

WISCONSIN 34 Washington St 16. We were not impressed with Washington St's offense vs Idaho last week. Meanwhile, the Badgers looked like they were in mid-season form getting a shutout on defense while RB Braelon Allen ran for 148 yards. Lean on the home team.

COLORADO ST 32 Middle Tennessee 25. Sharp money came in big time on Colorado St last night. The Rams got destroyed at Michigan last week while Middle Tennessee was destroyed vs FBS newcomer James Madison. We just can't lay 11.

MICHIGAN ST 46 Akron 10. Both teams won last week but we weren't overly impressed with either. Michigan St only led WMU 21-13 entering the 4Q. Meanwhile, Akron was extremely fortunate to beat FCS St. Francis in head coach Joe Moorhead's debut. We bet MSU -34 on the openers thinking this line closes -35.

ILLINOIS 27 Virginia 26. We disagree with both the side and total (we like UNDER) in this game. We like Virginia +4.5 as we can't lay points with an Illini offense that continues to trip over themselves (see their game vs Indiana last week). Our power ratings are real strong on UVA

CALIFORNIA 31 UNLV 19. UNLV comes in off a bye after destroying Idaho St. The Rebels have upgraded their talent via the transfer portal led by WR Ricky White (182 yards). Meanwhile, a lot of respected money came in against Cal last week. While that money lost, it was absolutely the right side as their opponent Cal Poly had 5 different trips deep in Cal territory end in ZERO points. That's in addition to a "Pick Six" for Cal. At "+14" this becomes a big bet for us.

3★ TEXAS TECH 34 Houston 28. Yes, we know that Texas Tech will be without starting QB Tyler Shough. We're here to tell you he's not that valuable. Donovan Smith has plenty of experience and maybe more upside. He started the blowout win over Mississippi St in the bowl and was sharp last week as well. We're also fading Houston off that 3OT win over UTSA last week. Houston had a 4% postgame win expectancy!! They get out-classed here vs new Texas Tech coach Joey McGuire who will want to establish some in-state superiority.

IOWA 23 Iowa St 19. Obviously, Iowa got a lot of negative press this week for their woeful offensive performance. QB Spencer Petras had the lowest total QBR of any QB in a win in the last 10 years. The good news is the defense allowed just 2.1 yards per play, notched two safeties and punter Tory Taylor had seven punts downed inside the 20. We're not sure what to make of an inexperienced Iowa St team who beat FCS SE Missouri St. Iowa has won 6 straight in the series and Matt Campbell has never beat Kirk Ferentz (0-5).

EAST CAROLINA 31 Old Dominion 20. ODU notched one of their biggest wins in program history last week vs Virginia Tech. They were +3 in TO's and only had a 25% win expectancy rate. Meanwhile, East Carolina had a 57% win expectancy rate vs NC State. Their special teams did them in as NC State got a blocked punt TD and ECU missed a couple kicks late. We think ECU is the right side but can't lay the current number.

WEST VIRGINIA 35 Kansas 21. Kansas is off a blowout win. You don't hear that much but the Jayhawks continue to improve under Lance Leipold. West Virginia impressed us even in a loss vs Pitt last week as they controlled the line of scrimmage. We think this lands near the number.

Uab 28 LIBERTY 22. QB Charlie Brewer will be out for this game as Johnathan Bennett and Kaidon Salter got snaps last week. Liberty was fortunate to beat Southern Miss as they only had a 24% win expectancy rate. UAB easily took care of an FCS team, has extra time to prep and has revenge for getting embarrassed in their stadium opener vs Liberty last year.

FLORIDA 28 Kentucky 24. The Billy Napier era got off to a great start with an upset over Utah. The Gators won the stats but also made the necessary plays in the red zone all game long. Meanwhile, Kentucky found themselves in a 10-10 game vs Miami, OH late 2Q. It was 27-10 with 14 minutes left 3Q thanks to a kick return TD and a near fumble return TD.

TOLEDO 40 Massachusetts 12. We actually watched a lot of the Toledo/LIU game last week. The Rockets front 7 on defense is Big Ten caliber but the offense left a lot to be desired in the non-covering win. UMass was blown out (what's new) in Don Brown's debut. More of the same here.

Syracuse 37 CONNECTICUT 14. We bet UNDER on the openers. Syracuse's defense under Tony White doesn't get enough credit. They allowed just 7 points last week in the upset over Louisville. Meanwhile, Jim Mora has UConn playing better on both sides of the ball (2-0 ATS and 2-0 to the UNDER). We can't recommend side or total at the current numbers.

OKLAHOMA 49 Kent St 17. Oklahoma got off to a nice start in the Venables era last week while Kent St got blown out at Washington. We bet UNDER 70.5 on the openers. The market has moved against us.

UL-LAFAYETTE 34 Eastern Michigan 22. Both teams played FCS teams last week and we'll get a better look in this game. EMU was actually out-gained by 100 yards vs Eastern Kentucky. We bet UNDER their season win total so we are looking to play against them this year even though we like their coach.

TULSA 32 Northern Illinois 27. Tulsa had a misleading loss to Wyoming last week. Tulsa had a 521-399 yard edge but Wyoming got a fumble return TD and a blocked punt TD. Meanwhile, NIU struggled vs an FCS team. We think Tulsa is the right side here but our numbers are close to the line.

TEXAS ST 35 Fiu 21. We bet Texas St on the openers and gave them out as one of the top plays of the week to VIP customers. FIU had a postgame win expectancy of 27% and should have lost to a mid-level FCS Bryant team. Meanwhile, Texas St outgained Nevada but were -4 in TO's. However, we can't recommend laying the current 14.

AUBURN 36 San Jose St 14. Auburn has a big game vs Penn St on deck. We expect them to continue to play TJ Finley and Robby Ashford here. Meanwhile, Sn Jose St was very fortunate to beat FCS Portland St last week. The Spartans were +3 in TO's and still only won by 4 as 3-TD favorites. Near the number.

NEBRASKA 42 Georgia Southern 21. Who continues to bet Nebraska week after week? We're seeing money come in on the Huskers. They certainly didn't impress in a non-cover vs North Dakota last week. They have Oklahoma on deck and Georgia Southern's offense looked good last week as they transition to the pass.

Use 37 STANFORD 27. Lincoln Riley's debut was a big success as the Trojans won 66-14. It should be noted USC did benefit from THREE "Pick 6's". This week will offer up a tougher test. Check out Page 1 for the bad beat in the Stanford/Col-

gate game. We bet USC -5 in the summer along with Stanford +11.5. We're close to the current number. However, we would lean UNDER.

2★ OKLAHOMA ST 35 Arizona St 21. We think we're getting value here because of the Oklahoma St final from last week being misleading. OkSt led CMU 51-15 early in the 3Q. Meanwhile, ASU is taking a large step up in class and they are one of the least experienced teams in the country.

MICHIGAN 56 Hawaii 8. This is the largest point-spread in Michigan football history! It seems rich but Hawaii is already 0-2 ATS this year falling short by a combined 59.5 ATS points. Meanwhile, Michigan just beat a much better Mountain West team by 44 points. We're not involved.

VIRGINIA TECH 24 Boston College 23. We like Boston College here. Yes, their offensive line stinks. However, we got the better QB and the more proven head coach. VT had a bunch of TO's vs Old Dominion but that is what QB Grant Wells was known for at Marshall. Our power ratings made this game VT -1. Anything BC +3 or better is good.

UTEP 30 New Mexico St 17. We saw some UTEP money show late last night. We disagree. With a very low total, we can't lay this kind of number. We lean with New Mexico St in the I-10 rivalry.

2★ Baylor 28 BYU 27. Baylor had a 303-67 rush yard edge in last year's matchup and both teams return a ton on the OL and DL. Can BYU hold up? The other question here will be the health status of BYU WR's Puka Nacua and Gunner Romney who were banged up last week. Baylor outright.

FRESNO ST 30 Oregon St 29. Oregon St plays another top-notch Mountain West team this week. They easily passed the first test controlling Boise St 34-17 as they forced 5 TO's. We doubt they get that many this week vs a Fresno St team that has a loaded offense. To the wire.

Mississippi St 34 ARIZONA 23. Obviously, Arizona looks much improved as they upset San Diego St 38-20. There was nothing fluky about the final as the Wildcats dominated. They're taking a step up in class here vs a Miss St team that controlled Memphis. We bet Miss St -6 and UNDER 63 on the openers. Pass now.

Week 2 Computer Projected Lines for Every CFB Game

For the past six seasons we have posted computer projected lines for every game on Wednesday. **Games where there was of difference of more than 3 points saw our computer lines actually beat the Vegas line at a 421-355-12 (54%) clip! So far this season those games are 3-5.** That's pretty solid and actually better than our own handicapping in some seasons. Keep in mind, these computer lines don't take into consideration off-the-field factors like revenge or flat spots or if there are late-week injuries. They are basically a power-rating number difference between the two teams that also takes into consideration the home field advantage.

Of the 5 games where our computer is off more than 3 points compared to the Vegas line (highlighted), our favorite team this week to back would be **Virginia +4.5**.

The Comp column is the computer projected line and the Diff column is the difference between the Vegas line and the Computer line. "+" numbers in the difference column say back the underdog. "-" numbers in the difference column say back the favorite. Let us know if you have questions.

Buffalo 27 L.A. RAMS 26. The defending Super Bowl champs find themselves a home underdog to what many believe is the best team in the NFL this season and we agree as they were No. 1 last year in points differential. The Bills are without their star CB and that's not good news vs Cooper Kupp and the Rams offense. The Rams are one of our favorite teaser options up to +8.5.

Sunday, September 11th

Baltimore 26 N.Y. JETS 17. The Ravens ended last season with 6 straight losses and will want to wash the bad taste out of their mouths. Harbaugh is on a 5-0 SU/ATS run in season openers. Joe Flacco will start here for the Jets against his former team. The Ravens are 32-8 SU in Jackson's regular season starts. The Jets are 0-5 SU through Flacco's five starts for them, four in 2020 and one last season. Lean Ravens.

1★ New Orleans 24 ATLANTA 17. Drew Brees and Sean Payton are no longer on the sidelines but the Saints took a lot of money in this game all summer long driving the line up from -3.5. There's even whispers now that they can take down Tampa Bay in the division. Meanwhile, Atlanta is clearly a bottom 5 team in the league and some think they may be the worst team. Marcus Mariota is the new starter with Matt Ryan off to Indy. Long-time DC Dennis Allen gets win No. 1 as the new Saints head coach.

MIAMI 24 New England 21. It was not a good summer/fall camp and preseason for the Patriots. About 10 days ago we saw money come in on Miami driving this line from -2.5 to -3.5. It is Belichick vs a new head coach and a young QB but the Patriots also say good-bye to long-time OC Josh McDaniels and so far the transition hasn't been great. The Pats have also been terrible in Miami going 2-8 ATS their last 10 visits. Safe to say, we regret betting New England +3 earlier this summer. Pass now.

CAROLINA 21 Cleveland 20. Raise your hand if you had Jacoby Brissett vs Baker Mayfield as the starting QB's with Mayfield on the Panthers? We've seen a huge line move here with Watson suspended and Mayfield is an upgrade over Darnold. The Panthers were 4.5-point underdogs (VIP's got +3.5 earlier this summer) and now find themselves 1.5-point favorites. With such a low total, Cleveland at +7.5 is a good teaser option. The Panthers are just 10-23 SU under Rhule and really need this game.

2★ Pittsburgh (plus the points) CINCINNATI 24 Pittsburgh 20. Pittsburgh is dangerous in this spot with double-revenge from two disappointing losses to the Bengals last year. After 18 seasons, Big Ben is no longer the QB and Pittsburgh will start Trubisky here. Will there be a Super Bowl loser hangover for the Bengals? They go from hunter to hunted. We like Pittsburgh.

San Francisco 23 CHICAGO 16. The markets are really sour on the Bears this summer. We thought the play-calling was too conservative from rookie HC Eberflus in the preseason as he could've given his young QB Fields some better opportunities. The 49ers will go with Lantz at QB here. Not sure we want to lay the full TD on the road with a low total. Seems like a clear UNDER play for us.

Philadelphia 27 DETROIT 21. The Lions are getting a lot of good will for being on "Hard Knocks" this year. The reality is they don't have a good HC or QB but hey they did cover 7 of their last 9 games last year. Philly smashed this team on this field last year by 38 points. We lean their way again in this one.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Indianapolis 27 HOUSTON 20. Amazingly the Colts have lost eight straight regular season openers and have had now 6 straight years with a different starting QB. This year it's Matt Ryan's turn. We think the streak ends this year but can't lay a full TD on the road, even against a bad Houston team. We did see sharp money come in on the OVER.

WASHINGTON 23 Jacksonville 20. We'll make a prediction and say this will be the least amount of handle on any of the NFL games this week. Carson Wentz will get the start for Washington. Normally we would say Jacksonville is a great teaser option through the "3 and 7" corridor. However, we can't get ourselves to the window there. The game is a complete pass for us.

Kansas City 30 ARIZONA 24. A ton of money came in on KC the other day moving this line 2.5-points. It's not like Arizona QB Kyler Murray is out. With limits increasing this week in the markets, we'd consider it to be sharp money. Arizona typically starts strong and fades late (a trademark of a Kliff Kingsbury team). What will the KC offense be without Tyreek Hill? We're passing.

L.A. CHARGERS 28 Las Vegas 24. A really good division matchup here. The Chargers are the better team at home but there were a lot of good vibes with Las Vegas this preseason. Obviously, it's a rematch of the final regular season game that saw the Raiders win in OT with a playoff bid on the line. We're not going to be too involved.

Green Bay 24 MINNESOTA 23. Minnesota started to get some love in the betting markets as the summer went on. They have a new coach in Kevin O'Connell and while former coach Mike Zimmer was a money machine for several years, the Vikings had disappointed the last couple of seasons. Meanwhile, the Packers still have Aaron Rodgers but Devante Adams is gone. We like Minnesota as a teaser option as they had 14 games decided by one score. Another photo finish.

TENNESSEE 24 N.Y. Giants 17. We like new Giants coach Daboll but we're not sure he has the right pieces on offense especially at QB. Tennessee had the disappointing loss to the Bengals in the playoffs. They will stick with Tannehill at QB. We're not big on laying points but we like Tennessee here.

Tampa Bay 27 DALLAS 24. The second consecutive time these two teams meet in a season opener. A lot of money came in against Dallas this summer especially on their win total. They have OL issues now and depth issues at WR. Meanwhile, is there trouble in paradise for Tom Brady and Company? What was once optimism with his return has now turned a little sour. With it being the stand-alone game, if you had to get involved, we'd lean Tampa.

Monday, September 12th

DENVER 24 Seattle 19. Obviously you have Russell Wilson in his first start for Denver vs the team he'd been with for a decade. Seattle was 3-0 ATS last season when Geno Smith started in place of an injured Wilson, just 6-8 ATS in the games Wilson started. This lie has been on the upswing all summer with Denver originally -3.5. We lean Seattle now.

Note: These NFL lines have been out all summer and have been shaped up. It's already a tough market to beat with every 0.5-point being critical. We will have stronger plays starting next week.
