

Happy Easter!

Today is Easter Sunday, and the beginning of the Easter Season! To help us remember that Easter is more than just a day, here's the Legend of the Dogwood Tree. Read this so each time you see the blossoms you are reminded that we are in the Easter season — Rejoice!

Legend of the Dogwood

In Jesus' time the Dogwood was a much larger, sturdier tree. Because it was so large and strong they used it to make the cross that Jesus was hung on. The Dogwood tree was so sad that it was used to crucify Jesus. God sensed the sadness of the tree and promised it would never grow large enough to build a cross again. He made its branches narrow and crooked so it would not be suitable for a cross. God also blessed it with beautiful blossoms to help remind us of the joy of the Easter Season. These are the traits God gave the blossom as reminders.

The flower has 4 petals shaped like a cross.

The center of the flower represents a crown of thorns.

The edge of each petal is a dent where the nails went in, and they are stained with the color of Jesus' blood.

That's the Legend of the Dogwood! Although this legend likely originated in the USA in the early 1900's, it's a good reminder for us that even from sorrow beauty comes.
