Hotel Information



The Handlery Hotel San Diego, 950 Hotel Circle North, San Diego, CA 92108, is our host for the 2018 National Convention. Located in Mission Valley, it's adjacent to the Riverwalk Golf Course in Mission Valley and is only ten minutes from the San Diego International Airport. There's easy access to nearby Fashion Valley and Mission Valley Malls, Old Town San Diego, Balboa Park grounds and the Zoo, and Sea World.

We have blocked convention room rates between 3-6

September, and they will honor this price (based on availability) for three days prior to or afterwards for those of you who want to arrive the Labor Day weekend ahead of the convention or stay the weekend following. Rooms are king or double bedded (a rollaway bed can also be requested in a king-sized room) and will accommodate from one to four persons at the special rate of \$119. Check-in time is 1500; check-out time is 1100.

Accommodations include: flat-screen televisions, pillow top bedding, mini refrigerators and well-thought-out workspaces with ergonomic chairs. Additionally, there is complimentary WiFi in all guest rooms and common areas, complimentary local shuttle service (five-mile radius, excluding the airport), a Business Center with computer, printer and complimentary boarding pass printing, a Fitness Center, same-day laundry and dry cleaning service available, a heated outdoor pool and whirlpool, room service, Postcards American Bistro and 950 Lounge, the poolside Reef Lounge, and dog-friendly accommodations are available.

Rates cannot be changed at check-in or check-out for those who do not identify their affiliation at the time the reservation is made!

REGISTRATION FEE. Your registration fee of \$205 includes the following:

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MORE HELPFUL INFO

SUPPLY LOCKER. Our official Military Women Across the Nation Supply Officer will arrive armed with various items available to purchase from the Supply Locker, including caps, pins, patches, charms, jewelry, and many other MILWOMEN logo items. Additionally, she will bring various clothing samples to try on for size, and for ordering on site from the Supply Locker. Stock on hand can be purchased and taken with you; all other purchases made via the Special Order Form (available only at the 2018 MILWOMEN National Convention) will be shipped to you immediately after the conference *FREE OF CHARGE*!

SUPPLY LOCKER ASSISTANCE. Our Supply Officer does a fantastic job keeping us supplied with memorabilia and logo'd items, but she needs your help at the convention. It usually takes a village ... but in this case, it will take 7-10 volunteers to help man the store, process orders, and generally help serve customers.

SISTER-TO-SISTER HELPING HAND (formerly SHIPMATE ASSIST PROGRAM). Help a Sister in need or donate to those who require financial assistance to help defray their convention attendance. Beginning with the National Convention in Norfolk in 2010, this program was created to offset costs for our members who may require a bit of financial assistance or may otherwise be unable to attend the convention. Actual support will vary based on requirements and be limited to funds on hand. All requests will remain confidential and will be determined by a three-member board. Requests will be considered based on available funds and number of requests, and approved requests will be provided via discounted registration cost versus cash reimbursement.

ENTERPRISE CAR RENTAL. Please be aware that there is an Enterprise Car Rental office on site at the Handlery Hotel. For those arriving early (or staying afterwards), this is a convenient location to pick up and drop off your rental vehicle should you desire one during your San Diego visit. This additionally avoids the airport fees and taxes. We do not recommend that you rent a vehicle during the convention times, as there's no need to pay for a rental car (and associated parking fee at a specially negotiated price of \$5/nightly) to sit while you're attending the convention. Note that this location is closed on Sundays, and you should reserve online in advance to be certain to get your vehicle type. They are limited to stock on hand at this particular location: Hotel Circle - San Diego, 950 Hotel Circle North, San Diego, CA 92108.
