Planning on putting a pool up this summer? Keep in mind the Village Ordinance on Outdoor Swimming Pools:



Outdoor swimming pools with water capacity greater than 1,000 gallons must be entirely fenced with a fence no less than 4 feet in height. The fence shall be of a type not to allow passage of an object greater than 4" in diameter and not easily traversable or climbable by children. A side of a building may be used as part of the fenced enclosure so long as the resulting enclosure is entirely closed and protected from access by children. The wall of pool may be considered part of the fence so long as fence material extends above the water level or rim of the pool, no less than 1 foot.

Resident Notice:

An update to the Village Ordinances was passed at our May 2018 Board Meeting regarding golf carts. It now reads as follows:



65. Golf Carts: No Golf Cart shall be operated on any sidewalk in the Village of Sheridan. No golf cart may be operated on a roadway in the Village unless, at a minimum, it has the following: brakes, a steering apparatus, tires, a rearview mirror, red reflectorized warning devices in the front and rear, a slow moving emblem on the rear of the golf cart, a headlight that emits a white light visible from a distance of 500 feet to the front, a tail lamp that emits a red light visible from at least 100 feet from the rear, brake lights, turn signals, and a horn. When operated on a roadway, a golf cart shall have its headlight and tail lamps lighted as required by Section 12-201 of the Illinois Vehicle Code and its operator shall obey all Traffic Rules and Regulations as described in the Illinois Vehicle Code and Ordinances of the Village of Sheridan. *Any minor child on a golf cart shall be seated in a forward facing seat and secured with a lap belt, seat belt of other form on safety restraint.*

“JUST A REMINDER”

Chapter 11 of The Village of Sheridan Municipal Code



It is unlawful for anyone to permit any weeds or grass to grow to a height exceeding eight inches anywhere in the Village: any such weeds or grass exceeding such height are hereby declared to be a nuisance.

Penalty. Any person violating this provision of the article shall be fined between \$150-750. Also The Village of Sheridan may abate said nuisance and all expenses of the abatement will be charged to and paid by the owner/occupant via a lien on said property.

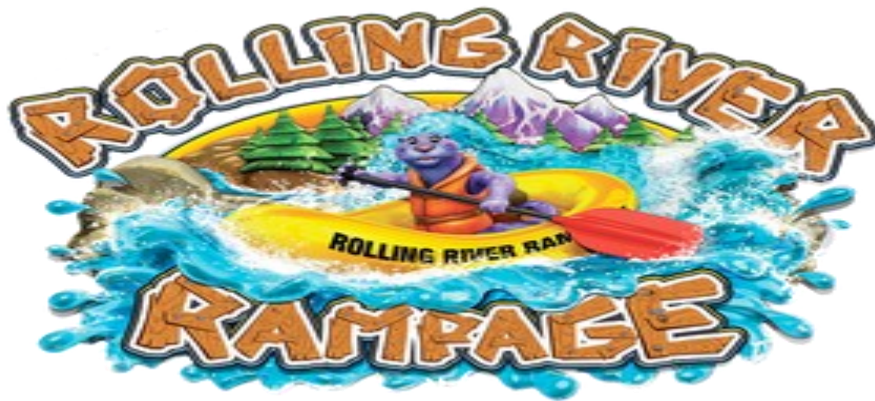

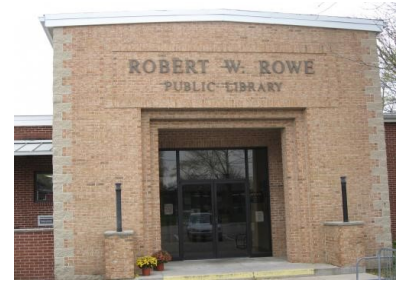
