NWOCA **Counselor of the Year** is presented to a counselor who provides outstanding services to their clients, who models exemplary ethical and professional behavior, and who shows commitment and dedication to the counseling profession.

NWOCA **Supervisor of the Year** is presented to a counseling supervisor who has provided exceptional counseling supervision. This individual shows a commitment to the advancement of counseling supervision and also utilizes the supervision hour as a time for the supervisees growth and development as a professional counselor.

If you know of someone who meets these criteria, please consider nominating them for the NWOCA Counselor of the Year or Supervisor of the Year award. Please provide a short letter (maximum of 300 words) indicating why you believe your nominee should receive this award.

Nominations must come from active NWOCA or OCA members. Nominees must be an active NWOCA or OCA member and should not be a previous recipient of the award. Letters of nomination should provide evidence that the nominee meets the criteria for the specified award.
