MRA Approves Merger with MCA

About 65 Madaket Residents Association members attended the Annual Meeting on July 14 and overwhelmingly approved a merger with the Madaket Conservation Association; there was a single dissenting vote. The vote of approval followed a slide show presentation by President Charlie Stott outlining the reasons for the consolidation and the benefits to be gained. MCA President Bill Grieder spoke as well, noting that the MCA Board unanimously recommends approval to the MCA members, and both presidents answered questions.

Interim by-laws were approved and a slate of interim officers was elected. The successful candidates will assume office in the consolidated organization if the members of the MCA approve the merger at the July 28 Annual Meeting.

The combined membership of the new organization will be about 230 families. The new by-laws include provisions for the new association's Board of Directors to take positions on issues, mobilize members and actively advocate for Madaket residents and visitors.
