

The Cowboy States Reining Horse Association co-affiliated with the Montana Reining Horse Association at the *Slide Into Summer Show and Derby* in **Livingston, Montana** on **June 21-23, 2019**. Eleven members of the CSRHA competed in the NRHA show at the beautiful Heart K Ranch. We would like to thank the Montana Reining Horse Association, who graciously allowed us to co-affiliate, thus making it count as our third affiliate show.

We would like to congratulate Brye Williams and her horse, *Stylish And Wavey*! This dynamic duo placed 4th with a 71 in the Rookie L2 class and came back stronger the following day in the Limited Non Pro where they rode for a 72 which won their first pewter trophy and a nice horse blanket. A special shout out goes to their trainer (and CSRHA Vice-President) Renee Pipinich for helping get these two competitors mentally ready for that amazing run! Keith, Stacy, and Lindsey Thomas hauled two horses, with all three family members competing. Keith Thomas rode *HF Shiney Surprise* to a win in the Intermediate Non Pro, Prime Time Non Pro, Masters Non Pro and 2nd place in the Non Pro with a score of 144.5. CSRHA President, George Pfeiffer showed *AMR Just Plain Firey* and came in right behind Keith with a score of 142.5, splitting 2nd place in the above classes, and splitting 3rd in the Non Pro. Keith also rode *HF Shiney Surprise* in the Non Pro Derby, finishing 6th with a score of 141. Keith and George also competed in the Novice Horse Non Pro class, where Keith split 2nd with a score of 71.5 and George split 5th with a score of 70.5. Lindsey Thomas rode both Thomas' horses to finish 1st and 3rd in the 10 and Under Short Stirrup class with scores of 71 and 69.5 and then repeated her performances in the 13 and Under class to split 1st and earned a 3rd place finish with scores of 70 and 69.5. CSRHA Vice President Renee Pipinich rode *Dunit Spooky* in the Open Derby earning a score of 144 which placed them 4th in the Level 1 and 5th in the Level 4 Derby. Thank you to all the family and friends who watched these outstanding riders in person and on the live feed.

The Heart K Ranch is a great facility, with camper hook ups adjacent to the stalls, a wonderful arena with excellent ground, and beautiful mountain scenery all around. Our thanks go out to the Montana Reining Horse Association for allowing us to use this show as our third NRHA affiliate show. This show served as the NRHA requirement of each affiliate hosting a minimum of three NRHA sanctioned events per year, but CSRHA points will not be tabulated for club shows and/or year-end awards at this event.
