

WEBA Beach Rules



Our beach is a Private Beach, Residents and WEBA Members Only. The following rules are in place to ensure the safe, responsible and courteous use of our beach.

- The roped area is for swimmers only
- The beach closes at sunset
- Alcoholic beverages are prohibited
- Fires are not allowed
- Dogs are not allowed
- Boats with motors are not allowed
- Canoes & kayaks may be launched from the far left side of the beach, outside of the roped swimming area
- Canoes & kayaks may be stored on the racks if you have paid the rental fee to do so, otherwise canoes & kayaks must be carried out at the end of the day
- Smoking of any kind is not allowed
- Glass containers of any kind are not allowed
- Take all trash home with you
- Do not park outside the fence area by the road
- Help to keep the beach clean, safe – please pick up any trash or other residue you may see
- Please keep the beach reasonably quiet – a courtesy to properties in the immediate vicinity
- There are No Lifeguards – use the beach at your own risk
