## FROM OUR DAILY BREAD

When we think of historic, trailblazing missionaries, the name of George Liele (1750-1820) doesn't leap to mind. Perhaps it should. Born into slavery, Liele came to Christ in Georgia and gained his freedom prior to the American Revolutionary War. He took the message of Jesus to Jamaica, ministering to the slaves in the plantations there, and served as the founding pastor of two African American churches in Savannah, Georgia one of which is considered the "mother church of Black Baptists."

Liele's remarkable life of kingdom service may have been forgotten by some, but his spiritual service will never be forgotten by God. Neither will the work you do for God. The letter to the Hebrews encourages us with these words, "God is not unjust; he will not forget your work and the love you have shown him as you have helped his people and continued to help them" (Hebrews 6:10). God's faithfulness can never be underestimated, for He truly knows and remembers everything done in His name. And so Hebrews encourages us, "Imitate those who through faith and patience inherit what has been promised" (Hebrews 6:12).

If we serve behind the scenes in our church or community, we might feel our labor is unappreciated. Take heart. Whether or not our work is recognized or rewarded, God is faithful. He'll never forget us.
