Preschool Classes at Brilliant Beginnings

All part-time preschool classes build upon the previous class. It is not necessary to take all three classes, however, we urge you to look at your child's current developmental and academic level to request the most appropriate class. We will assess each child at the beginning of the year to see what each child knows. The suggested age level of each class serves only as a guide for parents so socially they can be with their peers. Below is a list of skills focused on in each class.

Preschool Foundations (3 years- young 4 yr. old)

- Recognizing his/her name
- Introduction to letters
- Recognizing colors
- Identifying and drawing shapes
- Counting to 10
- Improving fine motor skills
- Learning independence
- Singing the alphabet
- Participating in circle time for 10 minutes
- Working on social skills

Preschool Essentials (4 yr.-young 5 yr. old)

- Reviewing skills from the Foundations class
- Identifying and writing uppercase letters
- Introduction to patterning
- Counting to 20
- · Writing first name
- Continue improving fine motor skills
- Participating in circle time for 15 minutes
- Group interactions
- Following simple instructions

Kindergarten Readiness (older 4's-6 yr. olds)

- Review the skills in the Foundations and Essentials classes
- Sharing and cooperating with peers
- Following multiple step instructions
- Effectively communicating wants and needs
- Identifying and writing upper AND lower case letters
- Counting to 30 and intro to counting by 2, 5, and 10
- Patterning
- Sorting by different means (color, size, texture, types)
- Recognizing numerals
- Rhyming
- Introduction to sight words
- Letter sounds
- Writing first and last name
- Recognizing and managing feelings
- Participating in circle time for 20 minutes
- Sequencing
- 1-to-1 correspondence
- Positional words
- Following classroom routines

All classes receive a high-quality education in a small group size (no more than 10-14 children). Each child is assessed three times a year to monitor developmental and academic progression. Preschool children get to participate in a fall and spring field trip, and either a park party at the end of the year, or a graduation ceremony for those entering kindergarten.

An age-appropriate snack is provided to help children with social skills associated with group eating. This snack consists a serving of 2 of 4 food groups exposing them to variety of foods.

Brilliant Beginnings screens all children for developmental level as per parent's and/or teacher's request. These results are given only to parents and teachers. Speech, occupational, and/or physical therapy can benefit a preschool child before entering Kindergarten, and is offered onsite if needed. All children must be fully potty trained to attend preschool, unless a medical condition exists.
