

LAST HOORAH! Endurance Ride 25/50 and INTRO

May 12, 2018

Six O Ranch Cleburne, Texas

Sanctioned by AERC and TERA, all rules apply. Negative Coggins required and WILL be checked at the gate for each equine in the trailer, upon arrival.

Endurance riding is a timed athletic event for both horse and rider. The event is open to all breeds of equine (horses, mules and ponies) at least 48 months old for 25 miles or 60 months old for 50 miles. The first goal is to safely follow a marked trail in the proper direction without missing any trail. The second goal is to ride the trail as quickly as the condition of the horse allows, successfully pass all vet checks, and finish with a healthy, sound horse.

LOCATION: Six O Ranch , 11404 FM 200 Cleburne, Texas 76033

Aprox 1 hr. south of Ft. Worth, Texas. At Cleburne, from Hwy 67 south, go towards Glen Rose. At Park Road 21, turn left and go 7 miles. Go PAST the Cleburne State Park. At Farm Road 200, turn right 3 miles. At the black mailbox, turn right and go up the concrete driveway to camp.

TRAILS: The trails consist of ranch roads, wooded sections, open meadows and rocky hills. This area has a lot of natural rock, so shoes are recommended.

CAMP: In an open field, no trees. Horse water is available. All dogs MUST be on a leash. No dogs allowed in shop where ride meeting is held. No bicycles, skateboards, scooters or ORVs of any type allowed. Camp will open Friday morning, May 11, at 8 am. Please no early arrivals unless you let Kim know, 817-558-7146.

PLEASE PRE-REGISTER. COMPLETE pre-entries receive a \$10 discount. Send the entry form filled out, a copy of negative Coggins, a copy of current AERC and TERA membership cards, and a check made out to Kim Reeves, to receive the discount, postmarked by May 1, 2018. Checks will be held until after the ride. *** 100% refund if you do not start the ride. ****

Veterinary or farrier bills to be paid by owner/rider at time of service. All veterinary decisions on a horse's fitness to continue or complete the ride are final.

Registration will start at 2 pm on Friday, May 11. Pre-ride vet exams will start at 3 pm and continue until dark. Ride meeting at 7 pm. A TERA officer will have a meeting for new riders prior to the ride meeting. There will be no non- competing horses allowed on trail on Saturday, May 12. There will be NO ties at the finish line.
