Training.....\$850/month

- Regular Training includes one private lesson on your show horse weekly. Additional lessons are \$35 each.
- Prospect training and development included in this rate.
- Consignment/Sale Horses includes marketing services (website, sale flyers, social media, mass emails) at no additional charge.

Farrier charges, veterinary charges, and any other medication, special services, equipment or supplies will be billed in addition to the regular monthly fee. Lessons are not cumulative and no credit is issued for missed lessons.

*Other flow-through show expenses (stall fee, portion of tack/feed/dressing rooms, bedding, entry fees, exhibitor/drug fees) will be billed in addition to these charges. **We do not prorate our personal lodging/meal or other travel expenses – it is included in the day fee.***

Body Clipping.....\$100.00

TERMS: Monthly invoices are mailed or emailed by the 1st of the month and due by the 10th of the month. There will be a 10% Late Fee charged on all accounts not paid by the 10th. We accept credit cards (Visa/MasterCard/Discover) for an additional 3.5% service charge (American Express 4%.) Horse show expenses will be billed prior to each show and due before leaving for the show. Any adjustments (change in entry fees, winnings, etc.) will be invoiced or credited on the following month’s bill.
