Calico Rock Museum Mission Statement

The Calico Rock Museum preserves, displays and interprets historical objects and works of art that **build a bridge** of culture and understanding.

Calico Rock Museum Foundation Purpose

The purpose of the Calico Rock Museum Foundation is to support and operate the Calico Rock Museum and preserve the culture, history and art of our community.

A Brief History

Calico Rock, Arkansas was incorporated in 1903, but had been established long before. French explorers and fur-traders were making their way up the White River when they spotted the bluffs jutting up from the banks of the river. They reminded the French of the calico-colored cloth popular at the time and called the place *calico roche*, or Calico Rock.

Unlike so many other areas along the river they had passed, the geography around the area where the calico rocks were located was more passable and became a suitable landing spot for expeditions. As steamboats began traveling the river in 1831, Calico Landing became an important trading post.

When Jay Gould's estate began building his railroad line connecting their considerable holdings in Memphis to St. Louis, they followed the river. Construction required the blasting the face of the huge bluffs. This action wiped away the calico-coloring that had given us our unique name, but the railroads made Calico Rock a boomtown. Calico Rock became the economic center of Izard County and, in fact, the entire region.

After 110 years, the calico-coloring on the bluffs is slowly returning and the history that has made our region great is being preserved and shared at the Calico Rock Museum.

Founded in 2008, the Calico Rock Museum is building a bridge between our past and our future.

The idea of a history museum had been discussed for years, but was finally begun when Susan Crosser Stumbaugh gave her father's collection of artifacts from the Calico Rock Depot to the community to build a museum. Jesse Crosser had served as the last station agent for the Union Pacific Railroad at Calico Rock.

Originally, the museum was located in the back half of the Calico Rock Industrial Development Corporation, an economic development organization supported by the City of Calico Rock. Within a short time, the non-profit Calico Rock Museum Foundation was established and granted 501 (c) (3) tax exempt status by the Internal Revenue Service.

The foundation raises money for and operates the Calico Rock Museum. Over time, the foundation has developed a strategic partnership with the City of Calico Rock to provide visitor center and museum services for the city. The foundation uses this contractual funding to help operate the museum and visitor center.

The focus of the Calico Rock Museum & Visitor Center has expanded to include the important art, culture, and history of the region. Today, the arts comprise a 75% footprint of the museum.

The Calico Rock Museum and Visitor Center is open Tuesday-Saturday, 9:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m. The center is closed on major holidays. To learn more visit www.calicorockmuseum.com.



Dear supporters,

The Calico Rock Museum Foundation enjoyed our most successful year in 2013. It marked the 5th anniversary of the Calico Rock Museum and was a **milestone year** of achievements.

We proudly submit this Annual Report to you, a valued stakeholder, and to the public in recognition of our accomplishments. Since the founding of the museum and foundation, we have been **on the move** because of you!

In 2013, the Calico Rock Museum Foundation:

- Remodeled the basement into a state-of-the-art conference room and exhibit space (doubling the usable square footage)
- Added new and upgraded several museum exhibits
- Hired curriculum specialists who developed educational programs which are being offered to school groups and the public
- had over 23,000 visitor contacts
- welcomed a record-breaking 2,000 guests to the Mountain Man Rendezvous and Native American Day in September
- acquired the historic Bluff City Bank Building from the city of Calico Rock, Arkansas securing our long-term facility needs
- remodeled the main floor of the museum to add a research Library, a new bathroom, and foundation office
- paid off our building acquisition loan after just 42 months, we are now DEBT FREE

This is our 5th anniversary! Since 2008, the foundation has:

- established the Calico Rock Museum & Visitor Center
- raised over \$400,000 in funds to support our mission and programs
- served over 70,000 visitors and guests through our programs and facilities
- developed an award-winning website which has served over 25,000 on-line visitors

In September, the city council demonstrated their faith and trust in the foundation's ability to serve our community by transferring ownership of the historic Bluff City Bank Building (former visitor center building) to the foundation.

The transfer of this building allows the museum & visitor center to combine our operations in a way that is far more efficient and better serves our guests and community. This action saved taxpayers \$42,000 over the next two years and secured the museum's long-term facility needs.

In 2013, we celebrated the 110th anniversary of the construction of the railroad at Calico Rock, the 110th anniversary of the first passenger train to arrive at Calico Rock, the 110th anniversary of the building of upper Main Street (including the 110th anniversary of our building), and the 90th anniversary of the rebuilding of lower Main Street following the devastating fire of 1923.

The Calico Rock Museum opened five years ago in the back half of the city's visitor center with no money and few artifacts to display. Five years later, we now own that building and the adjacent building. We have gone from about 600 square feet of exhibit space to over 6,000 square feet of exhibit, work and storage space.

None of this could have happened without your support. As a donor and leader in this effort, you have made a tremendous difference to the foundation and our community.

Of course, an Annual Report is a look backward at the significant accomplishments of the past year, but it is also a look forward. Because of the strong foundation that you have built, the Calico Rock Museum is poised for a very bright future. Strategic partnerships with the City of Calico Rock, fellow civic organizations, and the Calico Rock Artisans Cooperative provide the stability, strength, and growth opportunities we need to be successful in the next five years.

Moving forward will require the efforts of all of us working together to achieve our goals. As we begin this effort, we extend our sincere appreciation to you for keeping us **on the move!**







Every member of our board of trustees has given generously to the building campaign. A quarter of our building campaign gifts came from members of our board of trustees.

The foundation raised a quarter of the building funds through fundraisers, museum gift store sales, and strategic partnerships.

None of the building campaign funds required loss of local control or long-term commitments.

Programming Activities

Educational Programming

In addition to welcoming school groups and classes for tours of the museum, the foundation hired three curriculum specialists in 2013 to develop educational programs. These programs are tied directly to the Common Core curriculum. The museum hired educational presenters to present these one-hour programs. Several pilot programs were presented in fall 2013.

Public Programs and Events

In 2013, the museum held a number of public programs, crafting demonstrations, and classes on various topics related to the history and art of Calico Rock. These included pottery, candle-making, woodcarving, painting, and other crafting demonstrations. The programs also included classes on canning, soap-making, candle-making, one-room schools, and general stores.

Art Exhibits

The museum hosted the art students from Calico Rock High School and held a show of their work. In addition, the museum hosted exhibits of works by Emma Drown Morgan, Ruby Schaaf, and Glenda Herschberger.

Mountain Man Rendezvous & Native American Day

The most successful event in the history of the museum has been the Native American Day held in September, 2013. The event included a demonstration of Native American dance, a mountain man encampment, and a walk of remembrance for those who walked the Trail of Tears. A record-breaking 2,000 people attended the celebration.

The Storybook Project

The Storybook Project is a special project of the Calico Rock Museum Foundation. Volunteers go into the North Central Unit of the Arkansas Department of Corrections to allow inmates to record themselves reading a book to their child. The recordings and the books are then mailed to the children, so they can hear their incarcerated parent reading to them.

The hope for the project is to improve the literacy and love of reading in the children, strengthen the reading skills of inmates, and provide an invaluable connection between the incarcerated parent and their child.

Statement on Financial Condition

The Calico Rock Museum Foundation, Inc. is financially strong. The foundation closes 2013 debt free, having met all of our obligations, and having set aside the funds necessary to complete planned renovations to the museum facilities.

The foundation has developed strategic partnerships which strengthen our long-term financial condition and enhance our ability to serve our community. These include a contract to provide museum and visitor center services to the city of Calico Rock, services to the Calico Rock Chamber of Commerce, and a retail partnership agreement with the Calico Rock Artisans Cooperative.

The foundation is debt free and has no long-term financial obligations. The foundation board of trustees has established a strategic reserve as a "rainy day" fund. The board also established a construction savings account for the funds being raised for the final building renovations projects that will be completed in January-March, 2014.

In September, the city of Calico Rock conveyed the historic Bluff City Bank Building and Coal House property to the foundation. This building joins the museum property and previously served as the visitor center. Foundation management has reorganized the use of the joint facility which will save taxpayers \$42,000 over three years. Prudent management decisions have cut wasteful spending and greatly improved the long-term operational outlook for the facility.

A strategic partnership with the Calico Rock Artisans Cooperative provides for the efficient management and operation of the museum gift shop. Artisan members assist in the operation of the gift shop and museum and provide demonstrations for the public. The artisans association with the museum is reaping benefits for both organizations.

The foundation continues to show strength in donations, especially among small donors. Our success in reaching large, medium and small donors has brought the resounding success of the Calico Rock Museum & Visitor Center.

The financial condition of the Calico Rock Museum Foundation, Inc. is strong due to the prudent management decisions by the officers, executive committee, and board of trustees. The foundation is well-positioned for the future.

In the succeeding pages, the 2013 data statistics, operating budget spreadsheet, financial transactions, category spending report, and 2013 Form 990EZ tax return show the success of the foundation in every category of analysis. We are pleased to provide this report indicating the strength of the Calico Rock Museum Foundation.
