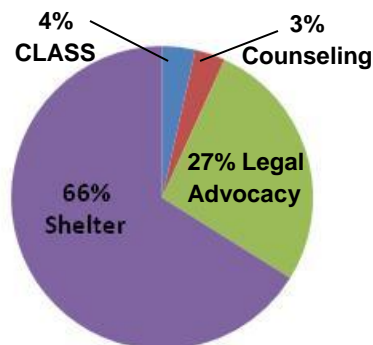
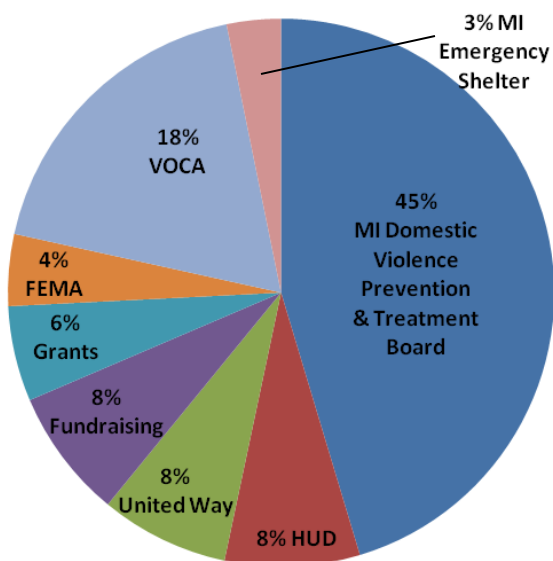
## *Our Philosophy*
