German Language School in Columbus.

Three Newark Maennerchor singers recently joined a non-singing tour of the sites of medievil and baroque empires of central Europe, walking the streets of Munich, Prague, Budapest, Vienna and Salzburg, cruising the Danube river and enjoying good food and evenings of Gypsy and classical instrumental music. The highlight of the tour was the famous and fabulous Passion Play that is attended by an audience of 4,000 each day and is produced and enacted every 10 years by the citizens of Oberammergau, Germany.
