MAYOR'S REPORT

LICENSES, ORDINANCE AND LEGAL

DISCUSSION: Second reading for Ordinance 1424. Alderperson McDowell moved for the adoption of Ordinance 1424. Adding a Subsection F to define "Spirits", and amending Class D licenses, to authorize the on-site sale and consumption of beer and wine in conjunction with the sale of food, as well as the retail sale of spirits, with no on-site consumption of spirits. The annual fee for such license is \$800. The motion was seconded by Alderperson Campbell.

ACTION TAKEN: Mayor Stadsholt asked if there were any questions, additions or comments. Alderperson French expressed concern with the City supporting gambling and the sale of alcohol, and the overall benefit to the community. The council respects and appreciates Alderman French's concerns.
