

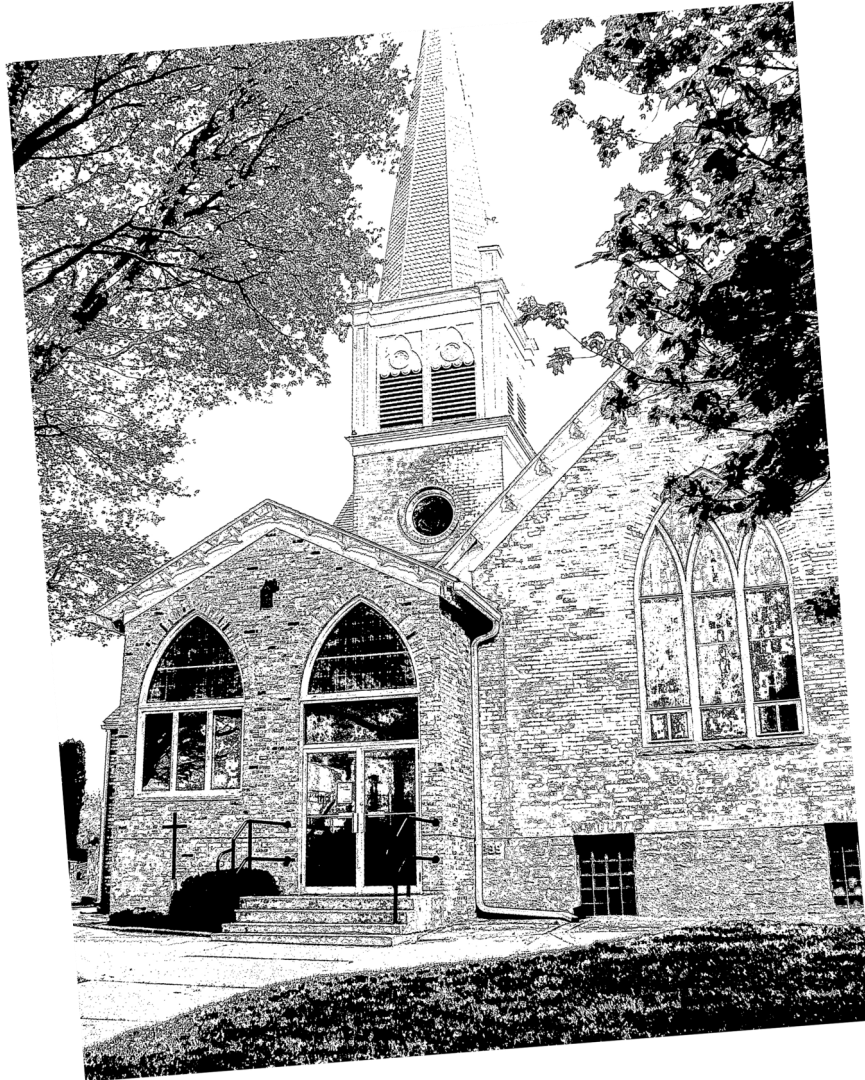

BURKE LUTHERAN CHURCH FUNERAL POLICY 2019

The Funeral: A Service Of Witness To The Resurrection

When death occurs, the pastor and other officers of the congregation should be informed as soon as possible, in order that they might provide appropriate consolation and support to the family and friends, and assist them in making arrangements for the funeral.

Services will be held in the sanctuary unless otherwise approved by the pastor. Anyone can have a service at Burke Lutheran as long as the pastor approves. Those wishing to have a service here who are not of the Christian faith should meet with the pastor and discuss how they would like to adapt the service to their beliefs. Final approval for all services and changes is done through the pastor.

Who can be buried at Burke Lutheran?

Church members of Burke Lutheran may be buried at Burke Lutheran. All funerals for persons who are not members will be approved by the pastor and the executive committee of the congregational council.

Who officiates at funerals at Burke Lutheran?

The pastor of Burke Lutheran will officiate at funerals. Exceptions to this policy will be at the invitation of the Burke pastor, in consultation with a member of the executive committee. Family members, friends, or members of the congregation may be invited by the minister to share in the service.

Who officiates in the absence of the pastor of Burke Lutheran?

The council president and vice-president will arrange for an ordained ELCA pastor to officiate in the absence of Burke Lutheran Pastor. If the pastor is on vacation, the pastor-on-call will be asked to officiate. Exceptions to this policy will be decided by the pastor and the executive committee of the congregational council. In the event that the pastor is unavailable, the executive committee of the congregational council will make the decisions.

Scheduling of the Funeral

The family, the funeral home and the pastor will confer to schedule the funeral.

Order of Worship

The order of worship in Evangelical Lutheran Worship will be the basis for the funeral worship. The service includes:

- Prayers
- Scripture Readings
- Apostles' Creed
- Commendation

Options that may be included:

- Hymns
- Musical Solo/choir anthems
- Pastoral Homily
- Sacrament of Holy Communion
- Words of Remembrance

Music and Musicians

Sacred music will be the norm. All music will be chosen by the family in consultation with the pastor and the organist. Hymns may be sung by the congregation. Solos and/or choral music may also be used. An organist of Burke Lutheran will normally be the organist for the funeral.

Funeral Pall

Burke Lutheran has a white funeral pall which may be placed on the casket prior to the very beginning of the service. This pall is a visual reminder of baptism into Christ.

Bulletins for Worship

The order of worship may be printed on worship bulletins at no charge to the family.

The paraments of the current season of the church will be used.

Refreshments for the funeral

The funeral home or the pastor will contact the Burke Lutheran Church Women (BLCW) to make arrangements for a lunch following the funeral, if requested. See page 6 for further information.

Burial

Arrangements for burial will be made by the family and/or friends of the deceased and is a separate issue from the details of a funeral worship service. Alternate arrangements for ceremonies or tributes of military or fraternal societies may be made apart from the Christian worship service.
