REPORTS

HE STATED THAT WE WOULD GLADLY PROVIDE AN AMERICAN GRAVE SITE FLAG IF DESIRED AND INVITED THEM TO ATTEND OUR MEMORIAL SERVICE AT OLQP. ON MAY 28, STARTING AT 8:30 AM.

JOE ALSO REPORTED THAT HE HAS A BALANCE OF \$508.50 IN THE MEMBERSHIP BANK ACCOUNT.
