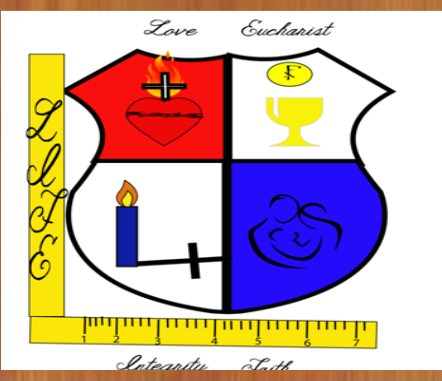

The Sacred Heart Of Jesus

"Please Father, what is the meaning of the burning heart on Jesus' chest?" — Kimara Hawthorne


The image you see of a burning heart on the chest of Jesus is called the image of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The image shows a real flesh heart with a wound made by a lance, encircled by a crown of thorns, with a burning flame on top, and a cross in the middle of the flame. The crown of thorns and the wound point to the manner of Jesus's death. The transformative power of Jesus' divine love is represented by the burning fire. In the image, therefore, we see a burning wounded heart of Jesus which symbolizes the love, compassion, and the suffering of Jesus. The image of the heart is the representation of Jesus' heart of flesh. In other words, it is the heart of his human body. As such, the heart also symbolizes Jesus' emotional and moral life.

As early as the eleventh century, Christians have paid special reverence and devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. This devotion is to the human heart of Jesus as well as to the love that comes from and is symbolized by it. The human heart and the love it symbolizes do not make for two distinct objects of devotion, but one and the same.


It is important to know that the Josephite Society that pastor our parish (St. Joseph [Maysville] Parish) is dedicated to and has a special devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Thus, the name: Society of St. Joseph of the Sacred Heart. In the Universal Church, the feast day of the Sacred Heart of Jesus is celebrated on the nineteenth day after Pentecost. It will be celebrated this year on Friday, June 27.
