### **CHURCH OPENING TIMES**

Places need to be booked through Deacon Geoff (812147 or 07765 075702) and please contact him no later than 6pm on the Friday before, so the seating arrangements can be sorted in plenty of time. Please also inform him, if possible before Sunday morning, if you have booked a place that you no longer want. This will allow the places to be reallocated and possibly, avoid having to turn parishioners away. Can parishioners also remember the social distancing guidelines as they leave the church and exit through the side door.

There are currently no booking procedures for attending Masses in Edlington or Balby – you can just turn up.

### **CARITAS HALLAM REFUGEE SPONSORSHIP SCHEME**

In the UK, support for refugee families is made available through the Community Sponsorship scheme (CS) and a subgroup of Caritas Hallam has been considering how CS could work in our diocese.

Community sponsors provide emotional and practical support to empower resettled families to rebuild their lives and to become self-sufficient members of their new community.

The two-year programme comprises three main elements:

- Housing – Find and prepare a suitable, affordable family home
- Funding – Raise a support fund to cover additional needs
- Support – Plan and deliver a programme of resettlement support

After security screening, medical checks and initial preparation about life in the UK, sponsored families arrive with full refugee status and the right to work, school places, free healthcare, English tuition (ESOL) and State benefits.

Geoff is interested in knowing if there are a group of parishioners, who would be interested in working together to supporting a resettled family, in Maltby. If you think you might be, please talk to him.

### **MALTBY FOODBANK**

77 families continue to be supported and last week, we had 17 parcels delivered to the more elderly, those with mobility problems and others who are isolating, while 40 families collected, from the church. There is a Maltby Foodbank Facebook page, which has the up-to-date shopping list, to enable us to put out the parcels. As with most weeks, our most important needs are tinned tomatoes, tinned meat, tinned fruit and toiletries.

Thank you to everyone who has donated the strong carrier bags. We will continue to have a need for them so please don't throw any out.
