ENTRIES MUST BE SUBMITTED BY MONDAY @ 12:00 PM. PLEASE READ AND BE PROMPT. WE CAN NOT ACCEPT LATE ENTRIES

NO EXCUSES...PLEASE READ SO YOUR KIDS ARE NOT DISQUALIFIED ON SATURDAY.

1. Go to the website https://ny.milesplit.com/calendar to input your entries. If you have questions on using milesplit please feel free to contact me at 607-279-5931.

The chart that accompanies this document will tell you specifically what races you may enter: For example: Large School or Small School for Modified Races, Seeded or Unseeded for Varsity Races.

If you have concerns with your placement you must discuss this with Todd James. Call him NO LATER THAN MONDAY @ NOON Cell (607) 279-5931

If you take it upon yourself to change races without checking with the meet director your team will be disqualified from that event.

11:00 Boys Varsity Seeded Race (Limit of 9 Runners)

Enter your Second Varsity Team in the Unseeded Race unless they are clearly JV caliber athletes. <u>Remember,</u> we are providing the option of nine entries because athletes will not be allowed to change to different races on Saturday. If you enter nine, you can delete them on Saturday but you can not move them to another race or replace them with another athlete on Saturday)

11:20 Girls Varsity Unseeded (Limit of 9 Runners)

If you have more than 7-9 runners enter the remaining girls in the Girls Junior Varsity Race. <u>Remember, we are providing the option of nine entries in the unseeded race because athletes will not be allowed to change to different races on Saturday.</u>

11:50 Girls Varsity Seeded (Limit of 9 Runners)

If you wish to enter a Second Varsity Team, please enter your next best 7-9 Runners in the Unseeded Race. Remember, we are providing the option of nine entries because athletes will not be allowed to change to different races on Saturday. <u>If you enter nine, you can delete them on Saturday but you can not move them</u> to another race or replace them with another athlete on Saturday.

12:15 Boys Junior Varsity (Unlimited # of Runners)

In order to enter boys in this race you must have a complete team in the Boys Varsity Unseeded Race or have special permission from the Meet Director. Call Todd James NO LATER THAN MONDAY- NOON at Cell (607) 279-5931.

12:40 Girls Junior Varsity, (Unlimited # of Runners)

In order to enter girls in this race you must have a complete team in the Girls Varsity Unseeded Race or have special permission from the Meet Director. Call Todd James NO LATER THAN MONDAY NOON @ Cell (607) 279-5931.

8. After all the athletes are in events, you may view your work by returning to the previous screen and clicking "View a List of Your Entries". <u>It is recommended that you check this for accuracy as you will not be allowed to switch athletes from one race to another on Saturday. We will only allow scratches on the meet day. Again, athletes will not be allowed to change from one race to another on meet day.</u>

9. To send the email of your entries to the host, click "Email your Entries to Host". You may send this email more than once, if necessary. Note that we will work with the most recent submission.

Larry's love for athletics and desire to watch young athletes excel and strive for perfection makes it only appropriate that this award is named in his honor. The award shall be presented to the Fastest Freshman Boy and Girl from the Varsity Race.

Grievance Committee Elimira, Groton, West Genesee Rules for the Meet

As we begin to approach Sectionals it is important for athletes to understand that rules will be enforced. For the benefit of the athletes we will abide by the rules of the National Federation. All decisions made by the Referee/Finish Judge will be final.

The Starting Commands will be based upon the NFHS Rule book for Track & Field/Cross Country.

Ties in Team Scoring shall be resolved by comparing the sixth place finisher from the tying teams. The team with the best sixth place finisher shall prevail. If one team does not have a sixth place finisher, the team with the sixth place finisher shall prevail.

The Uniform Rule will be in effect.

The Jewelry Rule is in effect.

Spikes may only be worn in ANY Race.

Any Runner who interferes with another runner shall be disqualified. Interference is any action by a competitor, which unfairly changes the course of natural running rhythm of another runner during a race.

Any participant who uses Unsportsmanlike or Unacceptable Conduct shall be disqualified. Conduct which is unethical or dishonorable which includes action and/or language which brings discredit to the individual or his/her school, disrespectfully addressing an official, using profanity, criticizing an opponent or an official or willful failure to follow the directions of a meet official are examples of unsportsmanlike or unacceptable conduct.

A runner shall be disqualified who is aided by another individual. A person who knowingly runs alongside a runner is considered to be aiding the Competitor.
