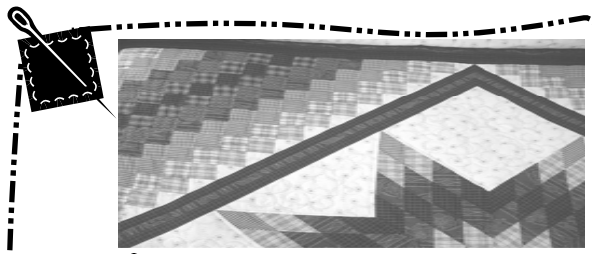

Monday, April 24

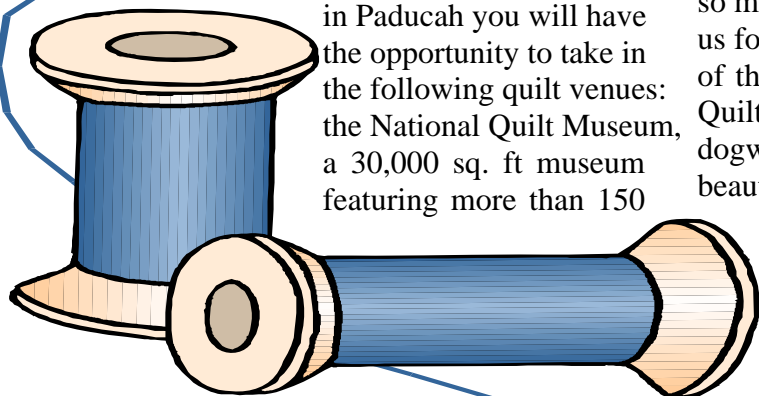
This morning we will depart Minnesota and “stitch” our way to a quilting paradise. Our first stop of the day is **Yellow Creek Quilt Designs** with quilting supplies (specializing in Civil War reproductions) and a gift store in the quaint little town of Pearl City, Illinois. Our evening stay will be in Rockford, Illinois.

Tuesday, April 25

After breakfast we will continue our Quilting Pattern through central Illinois, with our luncheon stop in Springfield. After lunch we will visit the **Main Street Quilt Company** of Shelbyville, IL. Selected as a Top Ten Quilt Sampler Shop of 2015, this full service shop is a provider of Plymouth Yarns and carries all major brands of quality quilting fabric as well as the latest books, patterns and notions.

Wed, April 26 – Thurs., April 27.

Breakfast is included both mornings at our hotel before driving the 45 minute commute into Paducah. Once in Paducah you will have the opportunity to take in the following quilt venues: the National Quilt Museum, a 30,000 sq. ft museum featuring more than 150



stunning fiber arts exhibits celebrating the international rebirth of quilting, and the **Kentucky Oaks Mall Quilt & Vendor Expo** – hosting various quilt vendors, displays and demonstrations. Also browse the fabric shops such as **Hancock’s of Paducah** – the world’s largest supplier of quilting fabric, **Quilters Alley** and many more. The main feature of your two days in this quaint town will be held at the Paducah Expo Center attending the **American Quilter’s Society Quilt Week – Spring**. In addition to exhibits of the most exquisite quilts being created today, AQS hosts a variety of special events, a vendor mall with approximately 400 vendor booths and a series of classes and lectures. Each year thousands of quilters participate in the AQS School of Quiltmaking, workshops conducted by world-renowned instructors. The original AQS QuiltWeek event is set apart by competitors, attendees and media contacts around the world. Paducah embraces QuiltWeek with quilt-related community and AQS-sanctioned events throughout the city, window displays and church dinners. Celebrate the depth of the fiber art experience with the Rotary Antique Quilt Show, Fantastic Fibers at Yeiser Art Center, African American Underground Railroad Quilts at the Hotel Metropolitan, Eleanor Burns’ Quilt in a Day and so much more. One day a step-on guide will join us for an explanation of the history and attractions of the area, as we learn why Paducah became Quilt City USA! It is also the season for the dogwood trees to be in full bloom; adding to the beauty of the area.

Friday, April 28

After breakfast we will continue our quilting pattern to St. Louis, MO taking in the **Budweiser Brewery and Stable Tour** followed

with lunch on your own at the Beer Garden. After lunch we will take the opportunity to ride to the top of the **Gateway Arch** for a great view of the St. Louis area. Our evening stay will be at the Drury Inn & Suites of Independence, MO – welcoming guests as their family. There’s something for everyone as their 5:30 Kickback rotating menu features a variety of hot food and drinks. It’s a snack for some, a meal for others, and free for everyone!



Saturday, April 29
