# A Message from Fr. Thomas Anatharackal CST

## The Holy Family

How can families grow together in mutual love, harmony, and care for one another? When God made a covenant with his people, he taught them his way of love: "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your strength - And these words which I command you this day shall be upon your heart - and you shall teach them diligently to your children." (Deuteronomy 6:5-6). God the Father's love is a covenant love that binds people together as his beloved children. His love is the cornerstone that binds man and woman in one flesh in marriage, and in their mutual love for their children, and for their children's children for generations to come. God wants his love to be the center of all our relationships and all that we do. That is why God gives us his Holy Spirit so we can love as he loves us. "God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us" (Romans 5:5). We love because he first loved us (1 John 4:19).

Jews were expected to travel to Jerusalem for the high feasts each year (Passover, Pentecost, Tabernacles). Jesus undoubtedly traveled with his parents every year from Nazareth to Jerusalem for the feast of Passover. This eight-mile journey normally took three days. So, families often traveled in large groups, for safety and comfort. Luke records a remarkable incident which happened when Jesus went up to the temple at Jerusalem for his first Passover at the age of twelve. It was at this key turning point in his earthly life that Jesus took the name "father" from Joseph and addressed it to God his Father in heaven. His answer to his mother's anxious inquiry reveals his confident determination to pursue his heavenly Father's will. *Did you not know that I must be in my Father's house? (Luke 2:49).* While Jesus identified himself as Son of the eternal Father in heaven, he, however, submitted himself with love and obedience to Mary and Joseph. The Lord Jesus came to show us the way to our Father's house and family in heaven. Listen to his word and obey him and you will find great peace, joy, and favor in serving him now and forever.
