**KREMMLING SANITATION DISTRICT**

REGULAR BOARD MEETING  
MARCH 13, 2017

The Board of Directors for the Kremmling Sanitation District met in the boardroom located at 200 Eagle Avenue. The meeting was called to order by President Jason Bock at 6:00 p.m. Directors present: Dave Sammons, Dwayne Uhrich. Director(s) absent: Jim Ward and Dave Jones. Staff present: Superintendent Jeremy Bock and District Manager Rich Rosene. Audience present: Maryann Van Lue.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** SAMMONS MOVED TO APPROVE THE REGULAR MEETING MINUTES OF FEBRUARY 13, 2017 AS PRESENTED. UHRICH SECONDED. ALL "AYE" VOTES.

**APPROVAL OF EXPENDITURES:** SAMMONS MOVED TO APPROVE THE EXPENDITURES PRESENTED FOR THE PERIOD OF FEBRUARY 14, 2017 THROUGH MARCH 13, 2017 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$130,302.04. UHRICH SECONDED. ALL "AYE" VOTES.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:** None.

**ENGINEER'S REPORT:** Superintendent Bock reported for the engineers that the in-kind replacement request for the two lift stations that were installed in 2009 has been submitted and we are still waiting for approval.

**OPERATOR'S REPORT:** Superintendent Bock said that he has 164 domes on site and is getting 2 to 3 loads per week with 8 domes each. The disk covers are now off of Pond C and it is being drained for the installation of the domes in mid-April.

Our seasonal worker, Chazz McEuen-Harvat, started work today. Bock has contacted Parker Ag to get a quote on removing the sludge in Pond A. They will use a sludge judge to estimate how much sludge they will remove with their press and haul off-site. The plans for Pond A need to be reviewed and approved by CDPHE and our two granting entities so that we can get the work done using grant funds. Sammons asked if we are getting improved treatment with the warmer weather and Bock said that we are. Bock said that Pond A is not doing as well with BOD removal due to the amount of sludge and the need for flow curtains and diffusers. The change of classification for Muddy Creek to non-drinking water this fall and the completion of the Bio-Dome project should get us through for several years before CDPHE comes back to review our permit. The only potential new change is in our phosphorus limit and that can be treated in the plant. The soda ash machine is operational and the pH was down to 6.52 and we are now at 7.4 so the soda ash machine was shut off. The soda ash machine has a new control box and is now fully operational so the payment to Wastewater Compliance Systems has been released. The new blower has been repaired and all four are up and running. There is still a seal that is leaking in one of the others and it will be repaired soon by Kaeser under warranty. Bock may look into selling the heater unit purchased for the blower building as the blowers seem to put off enough heat to keep the building warm. The whole set of blower issues started due to incorrect wiring at installation that gave the wrong voltage to the blowers.

**OLD BUSINESS:** Maryann Van Lue of the Hotel Eastin came before the board to ask for reimbursement on the plumber she hired to check the slow drainage of basement rooms. She was unable to rent out four rooms while the plumbing wouldn't drain. Her plumber, Rusty (Branstetter), asked for the sewer main to be checked as he had snaked all the way and still had a slow flow. Pat Etler checked the line and our main was slow even though it had been checked fairly recently. Sammons asked if a blockage in the service line could have been pushed into our main and caused the slowing. Bock said it could have, but there is no way of knowing at this time. Etler did jet the line afterwards and the hotel has not had any problem since. Rosene said usually a claim is for damage to carpeting or furnishings and we don't often get claims like this. The board asked if a split of the amount would be alright with Van Lue and she indicated it would. Sammons said it would be a good neighbor policy to help on this.

SAMMONS MOVED TO SPLIT THE BILL WITH THE HOTEL EASTIN IN THE AMOUNT OF \$300 EACH. UHRICH SECONDED. ALL "AYE" VOTES.
